APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In Case No. 23786, Devon seeks an order (1) establishing a standard 319.66-acre, more or less, spacing unit comprised of the E/2 W/2 of Section 35, Township 23 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, and Lot 3 (NE/4 NW/4 equivalent), the SE/4 NW/4, and the E/2 SW/4 of Section 2, Township 24 South, Range 29 East, NMPM, all in Eddy County, New Mexico. Section 2 is an

irregular section containing correction lots. And (2) pooling all uncommitted mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation, designated as an oil pool, underlying said unit. Devon proposes and dedicates to the unit the **Tater Tot 2-35 Fed Com 332H Well** as the initial well to be drilled to a sufficient depth to test the Bone Spring formation.

Devon proposes the **Tater Tot 2-35 Fed Com 332H Well**, an oil well, to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 2-24S-29E, to a bottom hole location in NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 35-23S-29E.

The proposed well is orthodox in its location, and the take points and completed intervals comply with setback requirements under the statewide rules.
