APPLICATION

- E.G.L. Resources, Inc. applies for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a non-standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of all of Section 13, Township 20 South, Range 33 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof, states:
- 1. Applicant is an operator in Section 13 (containing 640 acres), and has the right to drill a well or wells thereon.
 - 2. Applicant proposes to drill the following wells:
 - (a) The Hazel 13 Fed. Com. Well Nos. 401H, 601H, and 602H, with surface locations in the S/2S/2 of adjoining Section 12 and last take points in the SW/4SW/4 of Section 13;
 - (b) The Hazel 13 Fed. Com. Well Nos. 402H and 603H, with surface locations in the S/2S/2 of adjoining Section 12 and last take points in the SE/4SW/4 of Section 13;
 - (c) The Hazel 13 Fed. Com. Well Nos. 404H, 605H, and 606H, with surface locations in the S/2S/2 of adjoining Section 12 and last take points in the SW/4SE/4 of Section 13; and
 - (d) The Hazel 13 Fed. Com. Well Nos. 403H and 604H, with surface locations in the S/2S/2 of adjoining Section 12 and last take points in the SE/4SE/4 of Section 13.
- 3. Applicant has in good faith sought to obtain the voluntary joinder of all other mineral interest owners in Section 13 for the purposes set forth herein.

- 4. Although applicant attempted to obtain voluntary agreements from all uncommitted mineral interest owners to participate in the drilling of the wells or to otherwise commit their interests to the wells, certain interest owners have failed or refused to join in dedicating their interests. Therefore, applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying Section 13, pursuant to NMSA 1978 §70-2-17.
- 5. The pooling of all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying Section 13, and approval of the non-standard horizontal spacing unit, will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, applicant requests that, after notice and hearing, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation (Tonto; Wolfcamp /Pool Code 59500) underlying Section 13;
- B. Approving the non-standard horizontal spacing unit;
- C. Designating applicant as operator of the wells;
- D. Considering the cost of drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the wells, and allocating the cost among the wells' working interest owners;
- E. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure; and
- F. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling, completing, testing, and equipping the wells in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the wells.
