Ryan Gyllenband, being duly sworn, deposes and states:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a landman for Marathon Oil Permian LLC and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.
- 2. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum landman were accepted as a matter of record.
 - 3. My area of responsibility at Marathon includes Lea County in New Mexico.
- 4. I am familiar with the application filed by Marathon in this case, which is attached as **Exhibit B.1**.
 - 5. I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to this application.
- 6. I submit the following information pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1) in support of the above referenced compulsory pooling applications.
- 7. The purpose of this application is to force pool working interest owners into the horizontal spacing unit described below, and in the wells to be drilled in the unit.
- 8. No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests in the well.

- 9. In this case, Marathon seeks an order from the Division pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2W/2 of Sections 15 and 22, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico to form a 320-acre, more or less, Bone Spring spacing unit.
- 10. This proposed spacing unit will be dedicated to Frizzle Fry BS Federal Com 502 to be horizontally drilled with a first take point in the SE/4SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 22 and a last take point in the NE/4NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 15, to be horizontally drilled.
- 11. Attached as **Exhibit B.2** is the proposed C-102 for the well. The well will develop the Red Tank; Bone Spring pool, pool code 51683, which is an oil pool.
- 12. The well will comply with the Division's set back rules. The producing areas for the well is expected to be orthodox.
- 13. **Exhibit B.3** includes a lease tract map outlining the unit being pooled. Exhibit B.3 also includes the parties being pooled, the nature, and the percent of their interests.
- 14. I have conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the well is located, and conducted phone directory and computer searches to locate contact information for parties entitled to notification, and mailed the working interest owners well proposals, including an Authorization for Expenditure.
- 15. In my opinion, Marathon has made a good faith effort to obtain voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed well. A summary of my attempts to contact working interest owners is included in Exhibit B.4.
 - 16. Exhibit B.4 is a summary of my contacts with the working interest owners.

- 17. **Exhibit B.5** is a sample of the well proposal letter that was sent to all working interest owners. The proposal letter identifies the proposed first and last take points and approximate TVD/MD for the well.
- 18. Exhibit B.6 contains the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depths and length drilled in this area of New Mexico.
- 19. Marathon requests overhead and administrative rates of \$10,000.00/month for drilling a well and \$1000.00/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this area of Southeastern, New Mexico. Marathon requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.
- 20. Marathon requests the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against non-consenting working interest owners.
 - 21. Marathon requests that it be designated operator of the well.
 - 22. The parties Marathon is seeking to pool were notified of this hearing.
- 23. Marathon seeks to pool overriding royalty interest owners, and they were also provided notice of this hearing.
- 24. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.
- 25. I attest that the information provided herein is correct and complete to the best of my knowledge and belief.
- 26. The granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

Marathon Oil Permian LLC ("Marathon"), OGRID Number 372098, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA (1978), Section 70-2-17, for an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a 320-acre more or less Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2W/2 of Sections 15 and 22, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico. In support of this application, Marathon states as follows:

- 1. Marathon is an interest owner in the subject lands and has a right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Marathon seeks to dedicate the E/2W/2 of Sections 15 and 22, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico to form a 320-acre, more or less, Bone Spring spacing unit.
- 3. Marathon seeks to dedicate the spacing unit to the Frizzle Fry BS Federal Com 502 to be horizontally drilled with a first take point in the SE/4SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 22 and a last take point in the NE/4NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 15.
 - 4. This well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
- 5. Marathon sought, but has been unable to obtain, a voluntary agreement from all interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the proposed spacing unit to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well.

WHEREFORE, Marathon requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 7, 2024, and after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter its order:

- A. Pooling all mineral interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a horizontal spacing unit underlying the E/2W/2 of Sections 15 and 22, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico;
- B. Designating Marathon as operator of this unit and the well to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Marathon to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing this well;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure;
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.





Voluntary Agreement of Compulsory Pooling



Marathon will provide, upon request, a proposed Joint Operating Agreement ("JOA") for development of the Subject Lands that will include the following basic terms:

- Marathon Oil Permian LLC to be named as Operator
- Contract Area begin the Subject Lands
- As a charge for the risk involved in drilling the well, 300% of the above costs
- \$10,000 per month drilling overhead rates and \$1,000 per month producing overhead rates, adjusted annually pursuant to Section III.1.A.3 of COPAS form titled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."

If you would like to discuss a farmout, an assignment of interest, an acreage trade or other form of agreement for your interests in the Subject Lands, please contact the undersigned. If Marathon is unable to reach a voluntary agreement for the development of the Subject Lands with all the interest owners in the proposed spacing unit, Marathon will file an application with the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division for an order pooling the Subject Lands.

Election Instructions

Please use the attached ballot to indicate your desire to participate in each of the proposed wells and return a signed AFE for each well in which you elect to participate. If we do not receive a response from you within thirty (30) days, we will proceed with the necessary proceedings to pool your interests in the proposed spacing unit for the initial wells.

Elizabeth Scully, being duly sworn, deposes and states:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a geologist for Marathon Oil Permian LLC, and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.
- 2. I have previously testified before the Division and my credentials as an expert petroleum geologist were accepted as a matter of record.
- 3. My area of responsibility at Marathon includes the area of Lea County in New Mexico.
 - 4. I am familiar with the application Marathon file in this case.
- 5. **Exhibit C.1** is a locator map showing the approximate location of the proposed unit in relation to the Capitan Reef.
 - 6. **Exhibit C.2** is a wellbore schematic showing Marathon's development plan.
- 7. **Exhibit C.3** is a structure map of the top of the Second Bone Spring Sand formation. The proposed spacing unit is identified by a black dashed box. The proposed well is identified by a red line. The contour interval used in this exhibit is 25 feet. This exhibit shows that the structure is near flat.




- 8. **Exhibit C.4** is a cross-section reference map that identifies two wells in the vicinity of the proposed well, shown by a line of cross-section running from A to A'.
- 9. **Exhibit C.5** is a stratigraphic cross-section, and the well logs shown on the cross-section give a representative sample of the Second Bone Spring Sand formation in the area. The target zone for the well is identified as shaded area across the cross section. I conclude that Second Bone Spring Sand appears to be consistent across the unit.
- 10. Exhibit C.6 is an Isopach for the Second Bone Spring Sand. I conclude the Second Bone Spring Sand is about 400' thick.
 - 11. I conclude from the maps that:
 - a. The horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint.
 - b. There are no structural impediments or faulting that will interfere with horizontal development.
 - c. Each quarter quarter section will contribute more or less equally to production.
- 12. **Exhibit C.7** provides an overview of the stress orientation in the area based on the 2020 Lund Snee and Zoback paper.
- 13. The preferred well orientation in this area is North/South. This is because the S_{Hmax} is at approximately 60-80 degrees in mid-Lea County.
- 14. The exhibits to this affidavit were prepared by my or under my supervision or compiled from company business records.
- 15. In my opinion, the granting of Marathon's application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.


Locator Map





Structure Map - Top of Second Bone (TVDSS)











Reference Map for Cross Section



Stratigraphic Cross Section (Base of Second Bone Datum)








Structure Map - Second Bone Isopach






Preferred Well Orientation - SHmax

In support of this application, Marathon states as follows:

- 1. Marathon is an interest owner in the subject lands and has a right to drill a well thereon.
- 2. Marathon seeks to dedicate the E/2W/2 of Sections 15 and 22, Township 22 South, Range 32 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico to form a 320-acre, more or less, Bone Spring spacing unit.
- 3. Marathon seeks to dedicate the spacing unit to the Frizzle Fry BS Federal Com 502 to be horizontally drilled with a first take point in the SE/4SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 22 and a last take point in the NE/4NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 15.
 - 4. This well will comply with the Division's setback requirements.
- 5. Marathon sought, but has been unable to obtain, a voluntary agreement from all interest owners in the Bone Spring formation underlying the proposed spacing unit to participate in the drilling of the well or to otherwise commit their interests to the well.

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6. The pooling of all interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying the proposed unit will prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

- B. Designating Marathon as operator of this unit and the well to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Marathon to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing this well;
- D. Approving actual operating charges and costs charged for supervision, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedure;
- E. Setting a 200% charge for the risk involved in drilling and completing the well in the event a working interest owner elects not to participate in the well.
