AFFIDAVIT OF SOPHIA GUERRA

Sophia Guerra hereby states and declares as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a landman Avant Operating, LLC ("Avant"), and I have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have not previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and I have attached a resume summarizing my credentials as an expert petroleum land professional.
- 2. I received a Bachelor of Science in Business Administration degree from the Leeds School of Business at the University of Colorado.
- 3. Since receiving my degree, I have worked for Encana Oil & Gas (USA) Inc. as a Land Analyst, for Centennial Resource Production, LLC as a Landman, and Avant as a Landman. I have worked at Avant since November 2022. I am a member of the following professional landman groups: American Association of Professional Landmen, Women in Minerals.
 - 4. My area of responsibility at Avant includes the area of Lea County in New Mexico.
- 5. I am familiar with the application Avant filed in this case, which is attached as Exhibit A.1.

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- 6. I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to the application.
- 7. I submit the following information pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1) in support of the above referenced application.
- 8. The purpose of the application is to re-open Order No. R-22677, attached as **Exhibit A.2**, to amend it to allow for a one-year extension of time to commence drilling the initial well under the Order.
- 9. Order No. R-22677, issued in Case No. 23404, pooled uncommitted interest owners in a 240-acre, more or less, standard Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit E/2E/2 of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit").
- 10. The Order further pooled all uncommitted interests within the Bone Spring formation and dedicated the Unit to the Jet Fed Com 402H, Jet Fed Com 502H, and Jet Fed Com 602H wells (collectively "Wells") and designated Legacy Reserves Operating LP ("Legacy") (OGRID No. 294281) as Operator of the Unit and Wells.
- 11. Paragraph 20 of the Order states: "The Operator shall commence drilling the Well(s) within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well."
- 12. Further, Paragraph 21 of the Order states: "This Order shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to comply with Paragraph 20 unless Operator obtains an extension by amending this Order for good cause shown."
 - 13. Under the Order, the deadline to commence drilling the initial well is May 7, 2024.
- 14. Avant is the successor in interest to Legacy, is a working interest owner in the Unit, and has the right to drill thereon.

- 15. Good cause exists for Avant's request for an extension of time due to Avant's recent acquisition of the acreage at issue in the Unit.
 - 16. The transaction between Avant and Legacy closed in November 2023.
 - 17. Avant has been evaluating its development of this acreage since that time.
- 18. Avant is reviewing its drilling schedule and evaluating where these wells will fit into that schedule.
- 19. As a new operator of the Unit, Avant is also finalizing midstream dedications to acquire right-of-way and build infrastructure to this acreage in order to avoid unnecessary flaring once production is obtained.
- 20. For these reasons, Avant requires additional time to commence drilling given its acquisition of this acreage.
- 21. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.
- 22. In my opinion, the granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

APPLICATION

Avant Operating, LLC ("Avant"), OGRID Number 330396, through its undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") for the limited purpose of amending Order No. R-22677 (the "Order") to allow for a one-year extension of time to commence drilling the initial well authorized by the Order until May 7, 2025 and to substitute Avant Operating, LLC as the operator under the Order. In support of this application, Avant states as follows:

- 1. The Division issued the Order in Case No. 23404 on May 7, 2023, approving a 240-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico ("Unit").
- 2. The Order further pooled all uncommitted interests within the Bone Spring formation and dedicated the Unit to the Jet Fed Com 402H, Jet Fed Com 502H, and Jet Fed Com 602H wells (collectively "Wells") and designated Legacy Reserves Operating LP ("Legacy") (OGRID No. 294281) as Operator of the Unit and Wells.
- 3. The Order required Legacy to commence drilling the initial well within one (1) year of the date of the Order unless Legacy obtained a time extension from the Division for good cause

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shown. Order, ¶¶ 20-21. Under the Order, the deadline to commence drilling the initial well is May 7, 2024.

- 4. Avant is the successor in interest to Legacy, is a working interest owner in the Unit, and has the right to drill thereon.
- 5. Paragraph 20 of the Order states: "The Operator shall commence drilling the Well(s) within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well."
- 6. Further, Paragraph 21 of the Order states: "This Order shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to comply with Paragraph 20 unless Operator obtains an extension by amending this Order for good cause shown."
- 7. Good cause exists for Avant's request for an extension of time due to Avant's recent acquisition of the acreage at issue in the Units. Avant requires additional time to commence drilling given its recent acquisition of this acreage.
- 8. Accordingly, Avant requests that the Division extend the deadline to commence drilling the Wells to May 7, 2025. Avant also requests that it be substituted as operator under the Order.

WHEREFORE, Avant requests this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 7, 2024, and after notice and hearing, the Division as required by law, the Division amend Order No. R-22677 as requested herein.

Avant Operating, LLC ("Applicant"), successor in interest to Legacy Reserves Operating, LP, seeks an order amending Order No. R-22677 to extend the deadline to commence drilling the initial well under the Order and to substitute Applicant as operator under the Order. Order R-22677 pooled uncommitted interest owners in a 240-acre, more or less, standard Bone Spring horizontal spacing unit comprised of the E/2E/2 of Section 33, Township 18 South, Range 31 East, and the E/2 NE/4 of Section 4, Township 19 South, Range 31 East, Eddy County, New Mexico. Said area is located approximately 28 miles northeast of Carlsbad, New Mexico.

ORDER

The Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), having heard this matter through a Hearing Examiner on April 06, 2023, and after considering the testimony, evidence, and recommendation of the Hearing Examiner, issues the following Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Legacy Reserves Operating, LP ("Operator") submitted an application ("Application") to compulsory pool the uncommitted oil and gas interests within the spacing unit ("Unit") described in Exhibit A. Operator seeks to be designated the operator of the Unit.
- 2. Operator will dedicate the well(s) described in Exhibit A ("Well(s)") to the Unit.
- 3. Operator proposes the supervision and risk charges for the Well(s) described in Exhibit A.
- 4. Operator identified the owners of uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals in the Unit and provided evidence that notice was given.
- 5. The Application was heard by the Hearing Examiner on the date specified above, during which Operator presented evidence through affidavits in support of the Application. No other party presented evidence at the hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 6. OCD has jurisdiction to issue this Order pursuant to NMSA 1978, Section 70-2-17.
- 7. Operator is the owner of an oil and gas working interest within the Unit.
- 8. Operator satisfied the notice requirements for the Application and the hearing as required by 19.15.4.12 NMAC.
- 9. OCD satisfied the notice requirements for the hearing as required by 19.15.4.9 NMAC.
- Operator has the right to drill the Well(s) to a common source of supply depth(s) and location(s) in the Unit described in Exhibit A.

- 11. The Unit contains separately owned uncommitted interests in oil and gas minerals.
- 12. Some of the owners of the uncommitted interests have not agreed to commit their interests to the Unit.
- 13. The pooling of uncommitted interests in the Unit will prevent waste and protect correlative rights, including the drilling of unnecessary wells.
- 14. This Order affords to the owner of an uncommitted interest the opportunity to produce his just and equitable share of the oil or gas in the pool.

ORDER

- 15. The uncommitted interests in the Unit are pooled as set forth in Exhibit A.
- 16. The Unit shall be dedicated to the Well(s) set forth in Exhibit A.
- 17. Operator is designated as operator of the Unit and the Well(s).
- 18. If the location of a well will be unorthodox under the spacing rules in effect at the time of completion, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard location in accordance with 19.15.16.15(C) NMAC.
- 19. If the Unit is a non-standard horizontal spacing unit which has not been approved under this Order, Operator shall obtain the OCD's approval for a non-standard horizontal spacing unit in accordance with 19.15.16.15(B)(5) NMAC.
- 20. The Operator shall commence drilling the Well(s) within one year after the date of this Order, and complete each Well no later than one (1) year after the commencement of drilling the Well.
- 21. This Order shall terminate automatically if Operator fails to comply with Paragraph 20 unless Operator obtains an extension by amending this Order for good cause shown.
- 22. The infill well requirements in 19.15.13.9 NMAC through 19.15.13.12 NMAC shall be applicable.
- Operator shall submit each owner of an uncommitted working interest in the pool ("Pooled Working Interest") an itemized schedule of estimated costs to drill, complete, and equip the well ("Estimated Well Costs").
- 24. No later than thirty (30) days after Operator submits the Estimated Well Costs, the owner of a Pooled Working Interest shall elect whether to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or its share of the actual costs to drill, complete and equip the well ("Actual Well Costs") out of production from the well. An owner of a Pooled

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Working Interest who elects to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall render payment to Operator no later than thirty (30) days after the expiration of the election period, and shall be liable for operating costs, but not risk charges, for the well. An owner of a Pooled Working Interest who fails to pay its share of the Estimated Well Costs or who elects to pay its share of the Actual Well Costs out of production from the well shall be considered to be a "Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest."

- 25. No later than one hundred eighty (180) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the Actual Well Costs. The Actual Well Costs shall be considered to be the Reasonable Well Costs unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Reasonable Well Costs after public notice and hearing.
- 26. No later than sixty (60) days after the expiration of the period to file a written objection to the Actual Well Costs or OCD's order determining the Reasonable Well Costs, whichever is later, each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs shall pay to Operator its share of the Reasonable Well Costs that exceed the Estimated Well Costs, or Operator shall pay to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs its share of the Estimated Well Costs that exceed the Reasonable Well Costs.
- 27. The reasonable charges for supervision to drill and produce a well ("Supervision Charges") shall not exceed the rates specified in Exhibit A, provided however that the rates shall be adjusted annually pursuant to the COPAS form entitled "Accounting Procedure-Joint Operations."
- 28. No later than within ninety (90) days after Operator submits a Form C-105 for a well, Operator shall submit to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest an itemized schedule of the reasonable charges for operating and maintaining the well ("Operating Charges"), provided however that Operating Charges shall not include the Reasonable Well Costs or Supervision Charges. The Operating Charges shall be considered final unless an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a written objection no later than forty-five (45) days after receipt of the schedule. If an owner of a Pooled Working Interest files a timely written objection, OCD shall determine the Operating Charges after public notice and hearing.
- 29. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Pooled Working Interest who paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs: (a) the proportionate share of the Supervision Charges; and (b) the proportionate share of the Operating Charges.

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- 30. Operator may withhold the following costs and charges from the share of production due to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest: (a) the proportionate share of the Reasonable Well Costs; (b) the proportionate share of the Supervision and Operating Charges; and (c) the percentage of the Reasonable Well Costs specified as the charge for risk described in Exhibit A.
- 31. Operator shall distribute a proportionate share of the costs and charges withheld pursuant to paragraph 29 to each Pooled Working Interest that paid its share of the Estimated Well Costs.
- 32. Each year on the anniversary of this Order, and no later than ninety (90) days after each payout, Operator shall provide to each owner of a Non-Consenting Pooled Working Interest a schedule of the revenue attributable to a well and the Supervision and Operating Costs charged against that revenue.
- 33. Any cost or charge that is paid out of production shall be withheld only from the share due to an owner of a Pooled Working Interest. No cost or charge shall be withheld from the share due to an owner of a royalty interests. For the purpose of this Order, an unleased mineral interest shall consist of a seven-eighths (7/8) working interest and a one-eighth (1/8) royalty interest.
- 34. Except as provided above, Operator shall hold the revenue attributable to a well that is not disbursed for any reason for the account of the person(s) entitled to the revenue as provided in the Oil and Gas Proceeds Payment Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 70-10-1 et seq., and relinquish such revenue as provided in the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act, NMSA 1978, Sections 7-8A-1 et seq.
- 35. The Unit shall terminate if (a) the owners of all Pooled Working Interests reach a voluntary agreement; or (b) the well(s) drilled on the Unit are plugged and abandoned in accordance with the applicable rules. Operator shall inform OCD no later than thirty (30) days after such occurrence.
- 36. OCD retains jurisdiction of this matter for the entry of such orders as may be deemed necessary.
