AFFIDAVIT OF FARLEY DUVALL

Farley Duvall, being duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a landman for Marathon Oil Permian LLC ("Marathon") and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein.
- I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my 2. credentials as an expert petroleum landman were accepted as a matter of record.
 - 3. My area of responsibility at Marathon includes the area Eddy County in New Mexico.
- 4. I am familiar with the application filed by Marathon in this case, which is attached as Exhibit B.1.
 - 5. I am familiar with the status of the lands that are subject to this application.
- 6. I submit the following information pursuant to NMAC 19.15.4.12.A(1) in support of the above referenced application.
- 7. Marathon seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interests within a 640-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit underlying the S/2 of Sections 28 and 29, Township 22 South, Range 27 East, NMPM, Eddy County, New Mexico.

- 8. This spacing unit will be dedicated to the Magellan WC Fee 701H, Magellan WC Fee 702H, Magellan WC Fee 801H and Magellan WC Fee 802H wells, to be horizontally drilled.
 - 9. The wells are located approximately 1.9 miles from the Carlsbad Brine Well.
 - 10. Attached as Exhibit B.2 are the proposed C-102s for the wells.
- 11. The C-102s identify the proposed surface hole locations and the bottom hole locations, and the first take points. The C-102s also identify the pool and pool code.
 - 12. The wells will develop the Purple Sage; Wolfcamp Pool (Pool Code 98220).
 - 13. This pool is a gas pool with 320-acre building blocks.
 - 14. This pool is governed by the state-wide horizontal well rules.
 - 15. The producing areas for the wells is expected to be orthodox.
 - 16. There are no depth severances within the proposed spacing unit.
- 17. Exhibit B.3 includes a lease tract map outlining the unit being pooled. Exhibit B.3 also includes the parties being pooled, the nature, and the percent of their interests.
- 18. I have conducted a diligent search of the public records in the county where the wells are located, and conducted phone directory and computer searches to locate contact information for parties entitled to notification, and mailed the working interest owners well proposals, including an Authorization for Expenditure.
- 19. In my opinion, Marathon has made a good faith effort to obtain voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed wells.
 - 20. Exhibit B.4 is a summary of my contacts with the working interest owners.
 - 21. **Exhibit B. 5** is a list of the parties being pooled for this case.
- 22. Exhibit B.6 is a sample of the well proposal letter that was sent to all working interest owners. The proposal letter identifies the proposed first and last take points and approximate TVD/MD for the wells.

- 23. **Exhibit B.7** contains the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed wells. The estimated cost of the wells set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and is comparable to the costs of other wells of similar depths and length drilled in this area of New Mexico.
- 24. Marathon requests overhead and administrative rates of \$10,000.00/month for drilling a well and \$1,000.00/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this area of Southeastern, New Mexico. Marathon requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.
- Marathon requests the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against nonconsenting working interest owners.
 - 26. Marathon requests that it be designated operator of the wells.
 - 27. The parties Marathon is seeking to pool were notified of this hearing.
- 28. Marathon seeks to pool overriding royalty interest owners, and they were also provided notice of this hearing.
- 29. No opposition is expected because the interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed wells, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests in the wells.
- 30. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.
- 31. In my opinion, the granting of this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

AFFIDAVIT OF GREG BURATOWSKI

Greg Buratowski, being duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

- 1. I am over the age of 18, I am a geologist for Marathon Oil Permian, LLC ("Marathon"), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have previously testified before the Oil Conservation Division ("Division") and my credentials as an expert petroleum geologist were accepted by the Division as a matter of record.
- My area of responsibility at Marathon includes the area of Eddy County in New Mexico.
 - 3. I am familiar with the application filed by Marathon in this case.
- 4. **Exhibit C.1** is a locator map showing the approximate location of the proposed unit in relation to the Capitan Reef.
 - 5. **Exhibit C.2** is a wellbore schematic showing Marathon's development plan.
- Exhibits C.3 through C.6 are the geology study I prepared for the Magellan WC
 Fee 701H and Magellan WC Fee 702H wells, which will target the Wolfcamp A formation.
- 7. **Exhibit C.3** is a structure map of the top of the Wolfcamp formation. The proposed spacing unit is identified by a black-dashed line box. The Magellan WC Fee 701H and Magellan



WC Fee 702H wells proposed in this case are identified by the red line. The contour interval used in this exhibit is 25 feet. This exhibit shows that the structure dips gently to the east.

- 8. Exhibit C.4 is a cross-section reference map that identifies three wells in the vicinity of the proposed wells, shown by a line of cross-section running from A to A'.
- 9. Exhibit C.5 is a stratigraphic cross-section, and the wells shown on the cross-section give a representative sample of the Wolfcamp X-Y formation in the area. The target zone is identified by green shading.
- 10. **Exhibit C.6** is a Gross Interval Isochore map of the Wolfcamp X-Y and Wolfcamp A formations. Exhibit C.6 identifies the unit by a black-dashed line box and the Magellan WC Fee 701H and Magellan WC Fee 702H wells are identified by a red line. The gross interval thickness increases to the east of the unit.
- Exhibits C.7 through C.10 are the geology study I prepared for the Magellan WC
 Fee 801H and Magellan WC Fee 802H wells, which will target the Wolfcamp C formation.
- 12. **Exhibit C.7** is a structure map of the Wolfcamp C formation. The proposed spacing unit is identified by a black-dashed line box. The Magellan WC Fee 801H and Magellan WC Fee 802H wells proposed in this case are identified by the red line. The contour interval used in this exhibit is 25 feet. This exhibit shows that the structure dips gently to the east.
- 13. **Exhibit C.8** is a cross-section reference map that identifies three wells in the vicinity of the proposed wells, shown by a line of cross-section running from A to A'.
- 14. **Exhibit C.9** is a stratigraphic cross-section, and the wells shown on the cross-section give a representative sample of the Wolfcamp C formation in the area. The target zone is identified by green shading.

- 15. **Exhibit C.10** is a Gross Interval Isochore map of the Wolfcamp C formation. Exhibit C.6 identifies the unit by a black-dashed line box and the Magellan WC Fee 801H and Magellan WC Fee 802H wells are identified by a red line. The gross interval thickness increases to the south of the unit.
 - 16. I conclude from the geology studies referenced above that:
 - a. The horizontal spacing unit is justified from a geologic standpoint.
 - There are no structural impediments or faulting that will interfere with horizontal development.
 - Each quarter-quarter section in the proposed unit will contribute more or less equally to production.
- 17. Exhibit C.11 provides an overview of the stress orientation in the area based on the 2018 Snee-Zoback paper.
- 18. The preferred well orientation in this area is either north/south or east/west, because the S_{Hmax} is at approximately 45 degrees ENE in this area of Eddy County.
- 19. In my opinion, the granting of Marathon's application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.
- 20. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me, or compiled from company business records, or were prepared at my direction.

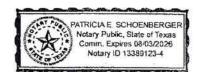

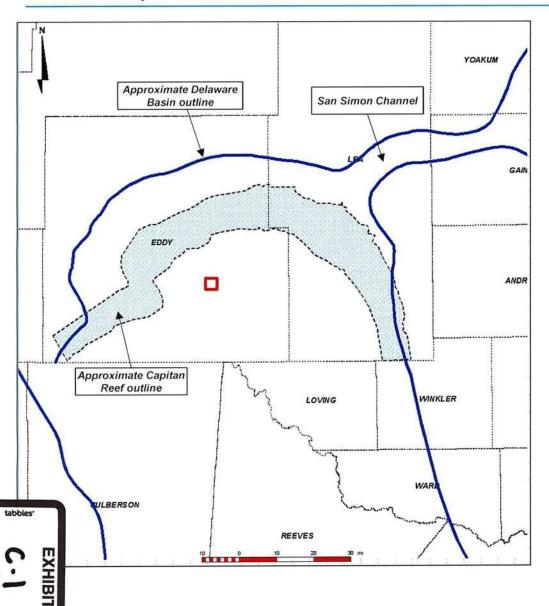

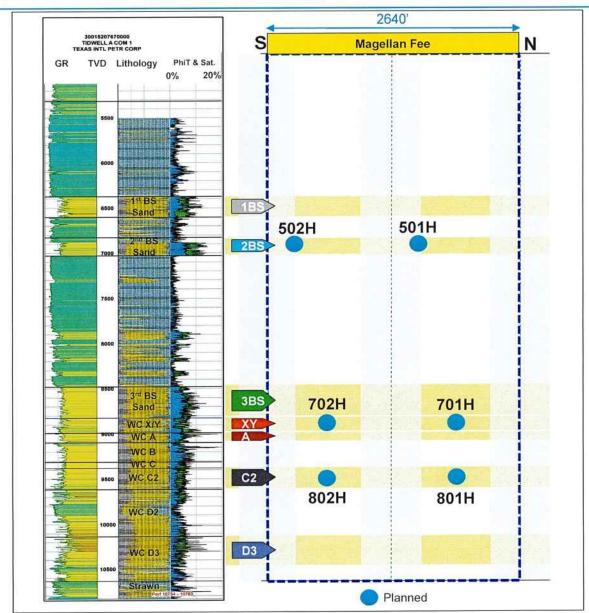
Locator Map

Wellbore Schematic

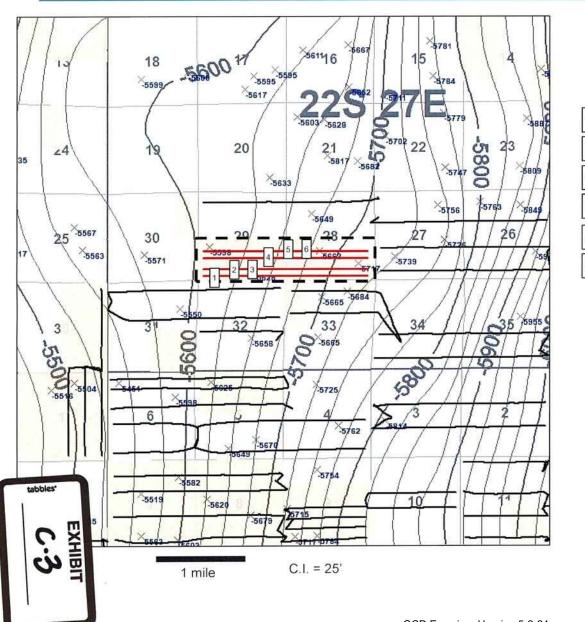

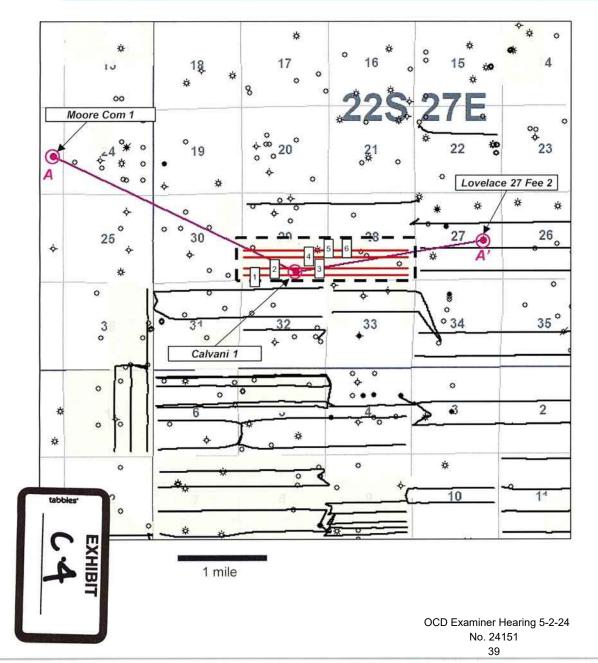

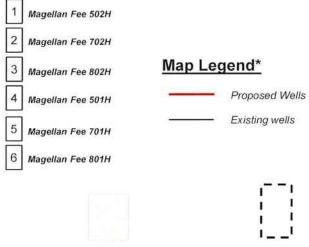

Reference Map for Cross Section



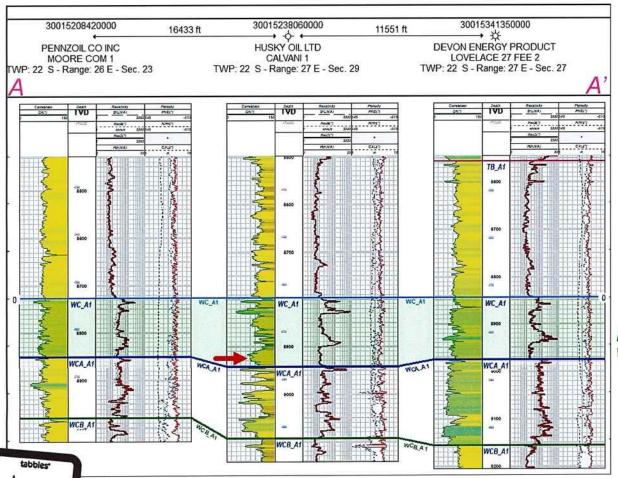


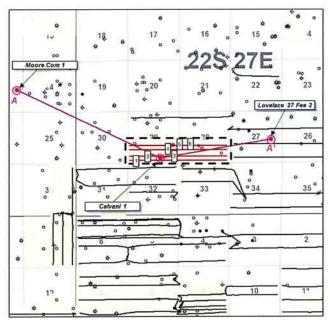

Stratigraphic Cross Section (Top Wolfcamp Datum)



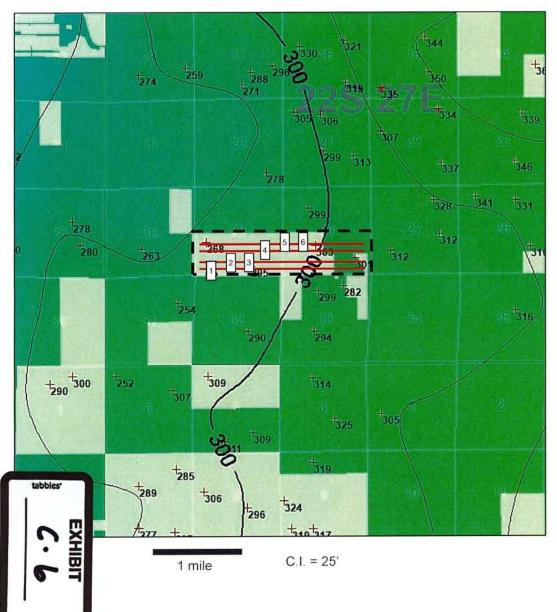


Producing Zone – Wolfcamp XY

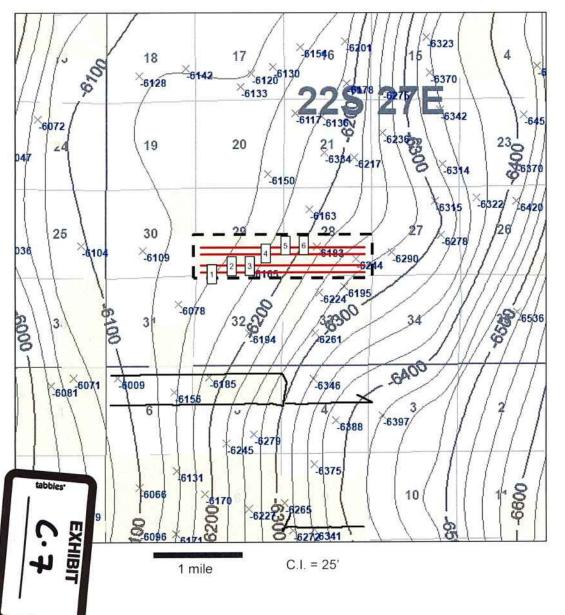

Structure Map - Top of Wolfcamp C (TVDSS)



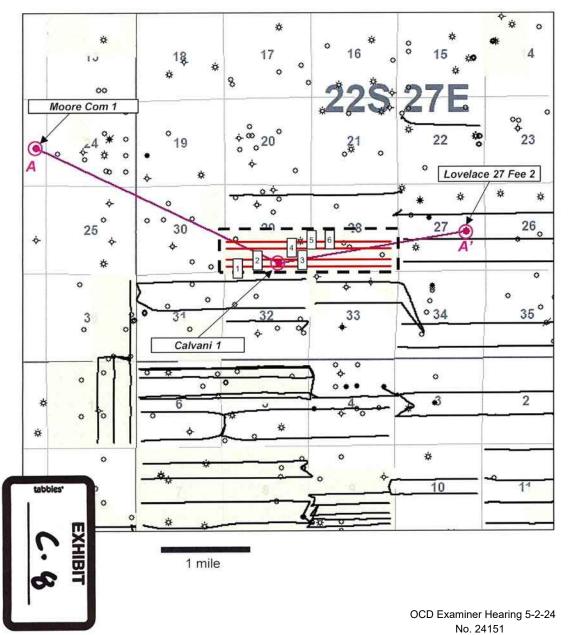

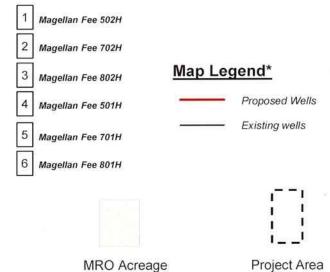

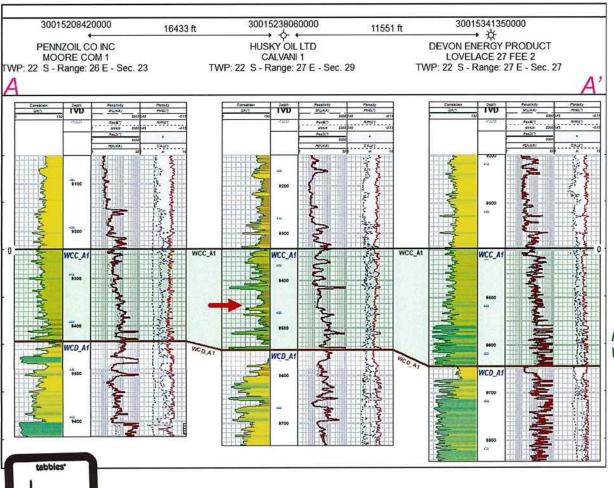
Reference Map for Cross Section

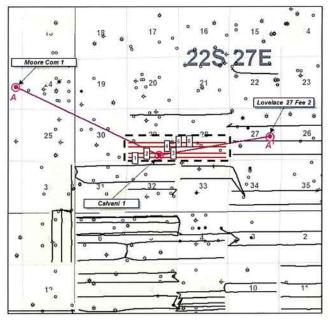






Stratigraphic Cross Section (Top Wolfcamp C Datum)





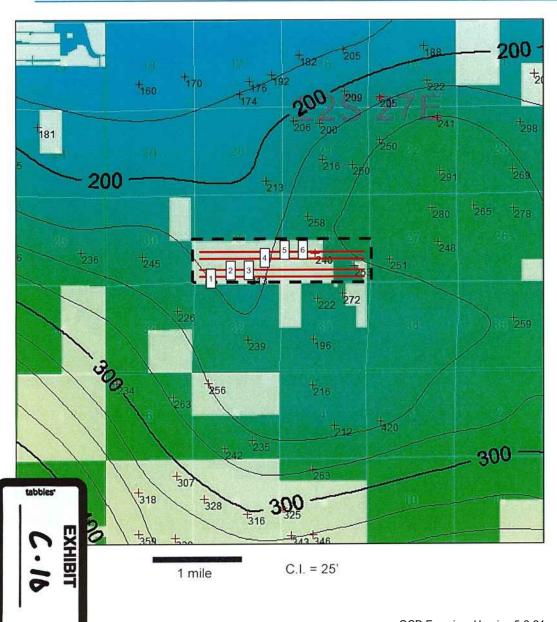

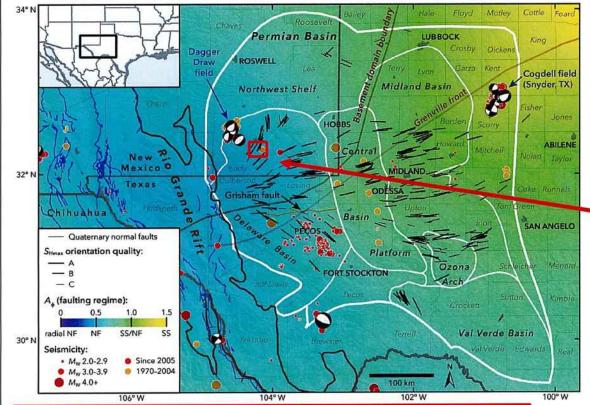


Figure 1. State of stress in the Permian Basin, Texas and New Mexico. Black lines are the measured orientations of the maximum horizontal stress (S_{lenn}), with line tength scared by data quanty. The colored background is an interpolation of measured relative principal stress magnitudes (rauting regime) expressed using the A_a parameter (see text for details) of Simpson (1997). Blue lines are fault traces known to have experienced normal-sense offset within the past 1.6 Ma, from the USGS Quaternary Faults and Folds Database (Crone and Wheeler, 2000). The boundary between the Shawnee and Mazatzal basement domains is from Lund et al. (2015), and the Precambrian Grenville Front is from Thomas (2006). The Permian Basin boundary is from the U.S. Energy Information Administration, and the subbasin boundaries are from the Texas Bureau of Economic Geology Permian Basin Geological Synthesis Project. Earthquakes are from the USGS National Earthquake Information Center, the TexNet Seismic Monitoring Program, and Gan and Frohlich (2013). Focal mechanisms are from Saint Louis University (Herrmann et al., 2011).

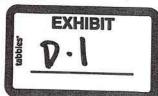
