APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Under Case No. 24537, EOG seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Lower Bone Spring formation (Red Hills; Lower Bone Spring Pool, Pool Code 51020) comprised of the W/2 of Sections 15, 22, and 27, Township 25 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. This spacing unit will be initially dedicated to the Pistolero 15 Fed Com # 301H, Pistolero 15 Fed Com # 505H, and Pistolero 15 Fed Com # 506H wells, all to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 15 to a bottom hole location

in the SE/4 SW/4 (Unit N) of Section 27; and the **Pistolero 15 Fed Com # 307H**, **Pistolero 15 Fed Com # 308H**, and **Pistolero 15 Fed Com # 507H** wells, all to be horizontally drilled from a surface location in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 15 to a bottom hole location in the SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 27. The completed interval for the **Pistolero 15 Fed Com #506H** is expected to remain within 330 feet of the adjoining quarter-quarter section (or equivalent) tracts to allow inclusion of these proximity tracts within the proposed horizontal spacing unit.

The completed interval for the wells will comply with statewide setbacks for oil wells. EOG has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all interest owners in the subject acreage.
