SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF JOSH ANDERSON

Josh Anderson, being duly sworn upon his oath, deposes and states:

- 1. I am a landman for Mewbourne Oil Company ("Mewbourne"), and have personal knowledge of the matters stated herein. I have been qualified by the Division as an expert petroleum landman.
- 2. Pursuant to Division Rules, the following information is submitted in support of this compulsory pooling application.
- 3. The purpose of this application is to force pool working interest owners into the Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit described below, and in wells to be drilled in the unit.
- 4. In this case Mewbourne seeks an order pooling all uncommitted mineral interest owners in the Wolfcamp formation underlying a proximity tract horizontal spacing unit comprised of the N/2 of Section 8 and the N/2 of Section 7, Township 20 South, Range 29 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico (containing 640 acres). The unit will be dedicated to the Jericho 8/7 Fed. Com. Well No. 712H, with a first take point in the NE/4NE/4 of Section 8 and a last take point in the NW/4NW/4 of Section 7.
 - 5. There is no depth severance in the Wolfcamp formation.
 - 6. A plat and C-102 outlining the unit being pooled are submitted as Exhibit 2-A.
- 7. The tracts in the unit, the leases, and the parties being pooled and their interests are set forth in Exhibit 2-B. The persons noted with an asterisk are being pooled.
- 8. The interest owners being pooled have been contacted regarding the proposed well, but have failed or refused to voluntarily commit their interests to the well.



- 9. In order to locate the interest owners, Mewbourne examined the county and federal records, performed internet searches, checked telephone records, and searched Accurint and Whitepages. Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to locate all interest owners.
- 10. Exhibit 2-C contains sample copies of the proposal letters sent to the interest owners. Mewbourne has made a good faith effort to obtain the voluntary joinder of the working interest owners in the proposed well.
- 11. Exhibit 2-D is the Authorization for Expenditure for the proposed well. The estimated cost of the well set forth therein is fair and reasonable, and comparable to the cost of other wells of similar depth and length drilled in this area of Eddy County.
- 12. Mewbourne requests overhead and administrative rates of \$8000/month for a drilling well and \$800/month for a producing well. These rates are fair, and comparable to the rates charged by other operators for wells of this type in this portion of Eddy County. They are also the rates set forth in the Joint Operating Agreement for the well unit. Mewbourne requests that these rates be adjusted periodically as provided in the COPAS Accounting Procedure.
- 13. Mewbourne requests that the maximum cost plus 200% risk charge be assessed against a non-consenting working interest owner.
 - 14. Mewbourne requests that it be designated operator of the well.
- 15. The attachments to this affidavit were prepared by me or compiled from company business records.
- 16. Granting this application is in the interests of conservation and the prevention of waste.

I understand that this Self-Affirmed Statement will be used as written testimony in this case. I affirm that my testimony in paragraphs 1 through 16 above is true and correct and is made under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico.
