APPLICANT'S STATEMENT OF THE CASE

Applicant seeks an order pooling all uncommitted interests in standard 40-acre directional well spacing units in the Wolfcamp and Bone Spring formations underlying the SW4 NE4 of Section 14, Township 17 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. Applicant proposes to dedicate the above-referenced spacing unit to the existing **Monika 14 17S 37E State 001** (30-025-49719), a directional well currently drilled in the Strawn formation from a previously approved non-standard location in the SW4NE4 (Unit G) of Section 14. Applicant intends to

recomplete the well initially in the Wolfcamp formation [Humble City; Wolfcamp (33510)], and then in the Bone Spring formation [Hobbs Channel; Bone Spring (31705)] as warranted.

Applicant seeks to have Matador Production Company (OGRID No. 228937) designated as the operator of these proposed spacing units and has been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of this acreage from all the affected mineral owners.

Applicant has separately obtained administrative approval of the non-standard locations in the Wolfcamp and Bone Spring formations under Administrative Orders NSL-8705 and NSL-8706.
