MRC Toro, LLC ("MRC" or "Applicant"), through undersigned attorneys, hereby files this application with the Oil Conservation Division pursuant to the provisions of NMSA 1978, § 70-2-17, for an order pooling a standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation underlying the E/2 E/2 of Sections 17 and 20, Township 25 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico. In support of its application, MRC states:

- 1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the proposed horizontal spacing unit and has the right to drill thereon.
- 2. Applicant seeks to designate Matador Production Company (OGRID No. 228937) as the operator of the proposed horizontal spacing unit.
- 3. Applicant seeks to initially dedicate the above-referenced horizontal spacing unit to the proposed **Dogwood 25 36 20 Federal Com 126H** well, with a surface hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 20, a first take point in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 20 and a last take point in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 17.
- 4. Applicant has sought and been unable to obtain voluntary agreement for the development of these lands from all interest owners in the subject spacing unit.

5. The pooling of interests in the proposed horizontal well spacing unit will allow Applicant to obtain a just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, will prevent waste, and will protect correlative rights.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on September 11, 2025, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the proposed horizontal well spacing unit;
- B. Designating Matador Production Company as operator of this horizontal well spacing unit and the well to be drilled thereon;
- C. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, completing, and equipping the well;
- D. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and
- E. Imposing a 200% charge for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the well.

SELF-AFFIRMED STATEMENT OF DAVID JOHNS

David Johns, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

My name is David Johns. I work for MRC Energy Company, an affiliate of MRC

Toro, LLC ("MRC"), as a Vice President - Land.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an

expert witness in petroleum land matters. My credentials as a petroleum landman have been

accepted by the Division and made a matter of public record.

3. I am familiar with the application filed by MRC in this case, and I am familiar with

the status of the lands in the subject area.

4. In this case, MRC is seeking an order pooling all uncommitted interests in a

standard 320-acre, more or less, horizontal well spacing unit in the Bone Spring formation

underlying the E/2 E/2 of Sections 17 and 20, Township 25 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea

County, New Mexico, and initially dedicate this spacing unit to the proposed **Dogwood 25 36 20**

Federal Com 126H well, with a surface hole location in the SW/4 SE/4 (Unit O) of Section 20, a

first take point in the SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 20 and a last take point in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit

A) of Section 17.

5. MRC understands this well will be placed in the

- 6. **MRC Exhibit C-1** contains the Form C-102 for the proposed initial well.
- 7. The completed intervals for the proposed well will remain within the standard setbacks required by the statewide rules set forth in 19.15.16.15 NMAC.
- 8. MRC Exhibit C-2 identifies the tracts of land comprising the proposed horizontal spacing unit. The land in the proposed spacing unit is comprised of federal and fee lands.
- 9. MRC Exhibit C-3 identifies the working interest and unleased mineral interest owners that MRC is seeking to pool, as well as the overriding royalty owners that MRC seeks to pool. The first pages of Exhibit C-3 shows the parties MRC is seeking to pool on a unit basis. Behind the unit analysis, there are additional pages showing the working interest and unleased mineral interest owners that MRC seeks to pool, on a tract by tract basis, along with their ownership interest in each of the tracts in the proposed horizontal spacing unit. The parties that MRC is seeking to pool are highlighted yellow.
 - 10. There are no depth severances within the Bone Spring formation for this acreage.
- 11. While MRC was working to put this unit together, MRC proposed the above well to the working interest and unleased mineral interest parties it seeks to pool. MRC Exhibit C-4 contains a representative copy of the forms of well proposal letters that were sent to the working interest and unleased mineral owners, along with the AFE that was sent for the well. MRC Exhibit C-4 also includes a copy of a clarification letter that was sent to certain of the owners. The costs reflected in the AFE are consistent with what other operators have incurred for drilling similar horizontal wells in the area.
- 12. MRC Exhibit C-5 contains a summary of MRC's contacts with the uncommitted working interest and unleased mineral interest owners we seek to pool in this case. As indicated on MRC Exhibit C-5, MRC has been able to contact and have discussions with many of the

working interest and unleased mineral interest owners we seek to pool. Also as shown on Exhibit C-5, there are some working interest and unleased mineral interest owners that MRC has not yet been able to contact, but it appears that MRC's well proposals were delivered to those owners. In addition, as shown on Exhibit C-5, there are a few parties to whom MRC has attempted to mail well proposals to two address and either left a voicemail and/or sent an email, depending on the potential contact information we were able to locate, but it is unclear at this time whether MRC has been able to locate the correct contact information for that owners. MRC will continue its efforts to contact those owners we have not yet been able to locate or contact. In my opinion, MRC has undertaken good faith efforts to reach an agreement with the uncommitted unleased mineral interest owners that MRC seeks to pool in this case.

- 13. MRC has made an estimate of overhead and administrative costs for drilling and producing the proposed well. It is \$10,000/month while drilling, and \$1,000/month while producing. These costs are consistent with what other operators are charging in this area for these types of wells. MRC respectfully requests that these administrative and overhead costs be incorporated into any order entered by the Division in this case.
- 14. I provided MRC's outside counsel, Holland & Hart, a list of names and addresses for the parties that MRC is seeking to pool for whom MRC was able to locate an address or potential address. In compiling this notice list, MRC conducted a diligent search of all public records in the county where the proposed wells are located, including computer searches.
- 15. MRC Exhibits C-1 through C-5 were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.
- 16. I affirm under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of New Mexico that the foregoing statements are true and correct. I understand that this self-affirmed statement will be

used as written testimony in this case. This statement is made on the date next to my signature below.

AFFIDAVIT OF BLAKE HERBER

Blake Herber, of lawful age and being first duly sworn, declares as follows:

1. My name is Blake Herber. I work for MRC Energy Company, an affiliate of

Matador Production Company ("Matador"), as a Senior Staff Geologist.

2. I have previously testified before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division as an

expert witness in petroleum geology. My credentials as a petroleum geologist have been accepted

by the Division and made a matter of record.

3. I am familiar with the applications filed by MRC in these cases, and I have

conducted a geologic study of the lands in the subject area.

4. MRC Exhibit D-1 is a locator map outlining the horizontal spacing units with a

black box shaded in yellow, with the larger area identified in a red box.

5. In these cases, MRC intends to develop the First Bone Spring and Third Bone

Spring of the Bone Spring formation.

6. MRC Exhibit D-2 is a subsea structure map prepared off the top of the Bone Spring

formation. The contour interval is 50 feet. The structure map shows the Bone Spring formation

gently dipping to the west. The structure appears consistent across the proposed wellbore paths. I

do not observe any faulting, pinchouts, or other geologic impediments to horizontal drilling.

7. Also included on MRC Exhibit D-2 is a line of cross section from A to A'.

- 8. MRC Exhibit D-3 is a structural cross section prepared displaying open-hole logs run over the Bone Spring formation from the three representative wells denoted from A to A'. For each well in the cross section, the following logs are included: gamma ray, caliper, resistivity, and porosity, where available. The proposed target intervals for the proposed wells are labeled and marked with a yellow shaded area. The logs in the cross section demonstrate that the targeted interval, within the Bone Spring formation, is consistent in thickness across the entirety of the proposed spacing units.
- 9. In my opinion, the standup orientation is the preferred orientation for development in this area for Bone Spring wells because the maximum horizontal stress is east-west in this area.
- 10. Based on my geologic study of the area, I have not identified any geologic impediments to drilling horizontal wells within the Bone Spring formation in the area of the spacing units proposed in these cases.
- 11. In my opinion, each quarter-quarter section will be productive and contribute moreor-less equally to production from each horizontal spacing unit.
- 12. In my opinion, horizontal drilling will be the most efficient method to develop this acreage, to prevent the drilling of unnecessary wells, and to result in the greatest ultimate recovery.
- 13. Approving MRC's application will be in the best interest of conservation, the prevention of waste, and protection of correlative rights.
- 14. MRC Exhibits D-1 through D-3 were either prepared by me or compiled under my direction and supervision.

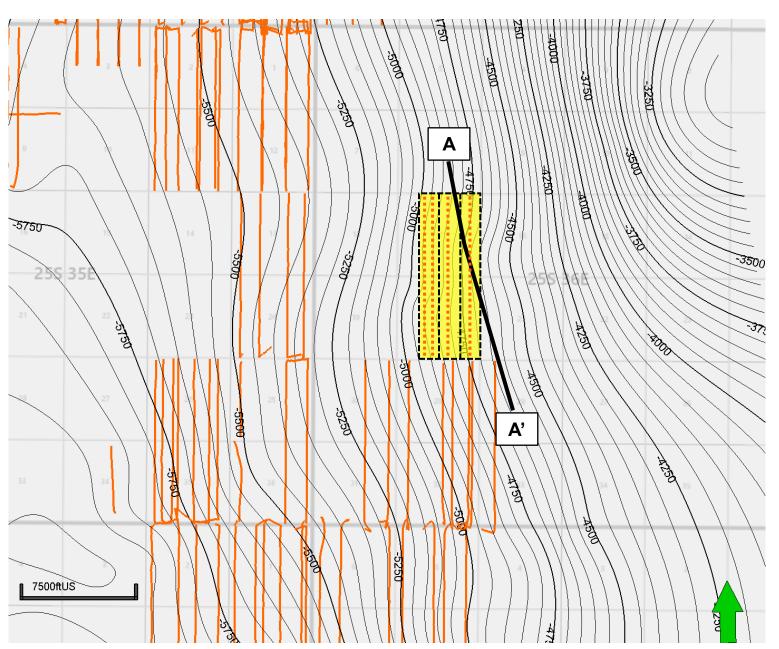

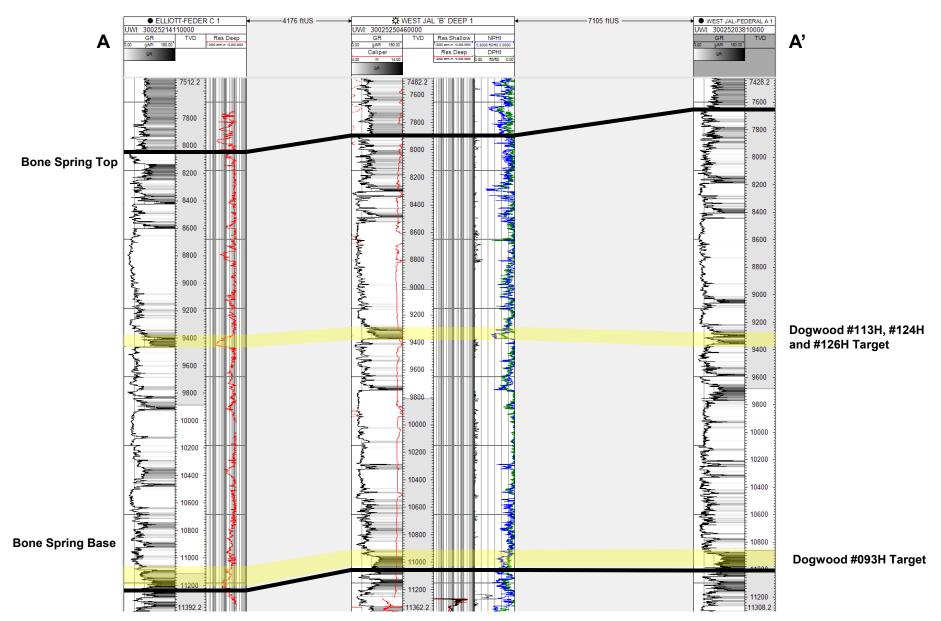
