The line the Saik #001 and the Mead #8 feed into will be abandoned. We have had leak history and our operations team is highly concerned being near the city of Carlsbad and crossing the Pecos. We are actively working with the other party to find this gas an alternative take away option or have them shut this well in. Ops will not allow any additional flow on this line, especially with it slated for abandonment.

The only option we have for you to flow gas to our system, is to lay a line to our new low pressure buildout southeast of you. We would set a meter and that would be the only cost you would bear in the buildout.
