**ORDER GRANTING IN-PART
CHEVRON U.S.A. INC.’S MOTION TO COMPEL
PBEX, LLC AND E.G.L. RESOURCES, INC. TO RESPOND
TO REQUEST NO. 6 OF THE SUBPOENA DUCES TECUM AND TO
DEFER THE TIME FOR CHEVRON’S RESPONSE TO THE MOTION TO DISMISS**

The Hearing Examiner, having heard oral argument by the parties and considered Chevron U.S.A. Inc.’s (“Chevron”) Motion to Compel PBEX, LLC and E.G.L. Resources, Inc. (“PBEX/EGL”) to Respond to Request No. 6 of the Subpoena Duces Tecum and to Defer the Time for Chevron’s Response to the Motion to Dismiss, and PBEX/EGL’s Response to Chevron’s Motion to Compel and otherwise being fully advised in the premises, FINDS that the motion should be GRANTED in part as follows:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED THAT:

1. PBEX/EGL shall produce the following documents responsive to Item 6 of the Subpoena Duces Tecum by Wednesday, **February 18, 2026**:
 - a. All correspondence with all pooled working interest owners enclosing an itemized schedule of estimated costs to drill, complete, and equip the wells (“Estimated Well Costs”) pursuant to Paragraph 24 of Order R-23684 or Order R-23685.
 - b. All correspondence with pooled working interest owners regarding their election to participate in the costs of drilling, equipping and completing any of the wells covered by the statement of Estimated Well Costs, or the payment of such costs, under Paragraph 25 of Order R-23684 or Order R-23685.
2. Chevron’s Response to PBEX/EGL’s Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Standing shall be filed by Wednesday, **February 25, 2026**.

If the Hearing Officer desires to hold a hearing to address the Motion to Dismiss for Lack of Standing, he will notify the parties.
