**APPLICATION OF SPUR ENERGY  
PARTNERS LLC FOR COMPULSORY  
POOLING, EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.**

**APPLICATION**

Pursuant to NMSA § 70-2-17, Spur Energy Partners LLC (OGRID No. 328947) (“Applicant”) applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Yeso formation underlying a 320-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of the S/2 of Section 10, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”). In support of this application, Spur states the following:

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the Unit and has the right to drill wells thereon.
2. Applicant seeks to dedicate the Unit to the following wells (“Wells”):
  - a. **Polo AOP Federal Com 1H**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 10;
  - b. **Polo AOP Federal Com 10H**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in NE/4 SE/4 (Unit I) of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of Section 10; and
  - c. **Polo AOP Federal Com 11H and Polo AOP Federal Com 70H**, to be drilled from a surface hole location in SE/4 SE/4 (Unit P) of Section 10 to a bottom hole location in SW/4 SW/4 (Unit M) of Section 10.
3. The completed intervals of the Wells will be orthodox.

4. The completed interval of the **Polo AOP Federal Com 1H** well will be located within 330' of the quarter-quarter section line separating the S/2 S/2 and N/2 S/2 of Section 10, Township 19 South, Range 25 East, to allow for the creation of a 320-acre standard, horizontal spacing unit.

5. Applicant has undertaken diligent, good-faith efforts to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners to participate in the drilling of the Wells but has been unable to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners.

6. The pooling of uncommitted interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

7. In order to allow Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted interests in the Unit should be pooled and Applicant should be designated the operator of the Wells and Unit.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on March 26, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the Unit;
- B. Approving the Wells in the Unit;
- C. Designating Applicant as operator of the Unit and the Wells to be drilled thereon;
- D. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the Wells;
- E. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and

F. Imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the Wells against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the Wells.
