**NEW MEXICO OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION'S AGREED MOTION FOR
CONTINUANCE**

NOW COMES Movant, the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division ("OCD"), moves for an order continuing the hearing on the above Notice of Violation ("NOV"), and in support thereof, states:

1. The above-referenced matter is currently set for hearing on April 15, 2026.
2. Respondent, Enerdyne, LLC, has agreed with the undersigned to continue the hearing until June 26, 2026, since the parties have agreed in principle to the terms of an SFO and Respondent has represented to OCD that the six (6) wells at issue can be plugged by June 26, 2006. Respondent has already agreed with OCD on a civil penalty and paid the agreed amount of \$520.00. Given the prospect of the wells being brought into compliance and a full and final settlement of the NOV being possible, OCD agreed with Respondent to a continuance of this case until the June 26, 2026 OCD docket.
3. This continuance is not being sought for purposes of delay, but so that justice may be done. A proposed order is attached hereto as **Exhibit A**.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, Movant requests that this case be continued to the June 26, 2026 OCD docket.
