STATEMENT OF THE CASE

In Case No. **25956**, Avant requests an order from the Division: (1) approving a non-standard unit, and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests within a non-standard 960-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit comprised of all of Section 21 and the N/2 of Section 28, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

Avant seeks to dedicate the Unit to the following wells, to be horizontally drilled:

- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #751H** well with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 21;
- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #752H and Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #753H** wells with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 21;
- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #754H** well with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 21; and
- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #755H** well with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 21.

The wells will be horizontally drilled, and the producing areas for the wells are expected to be orthodox. within the WC-025-G-09 S203435D; Wolfcamp pool (Pool code 98247).

In Case No. 25957, Avant seeks an order from the Division (1) approving a non-standard unit, and (2) pooling all uncommitted interests within a non-standard 960-acre, more or less, Wolfcamp horizontal spacing unit comprised of all of Section 21 and the N/2 of Section 28, Township 20 South, Range 34 East, N.M.P.M., Lea County, New Mexico.

- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #801H** well with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NW/4 NW/4 (Unit D) of Section 21;
- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #802H and Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #803H** wells with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NW/4 (Unit F) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NE/4 NW/4 (Unit C) of Section 21;
- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #804H** well with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NW/4 NE/4 (Unit B) of Section 21; and
- **Paloma 28 21 Fed Com #805H** well with a proposed surface hole location in the SE/4 NE/4 (Unit H) of Section 28, and a proposed last take point in the NE/4 NE/4 (Unit A) of Section 21.

The Lea; Penn (Gas) pool (Pool code 80040) is a gas pool which requires 330' setbacks for first and last take points, and 660' setbacks for the completed interval. AOII will request non-standard location approval to the extent necessary.
