**APPLICATION OF MEWBOURNE OIL
COMPANY FOR COMPULSORY POOLING,
EDDY COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.**

APPLICATION

Pursuant to NMSA § 70-2-17, Mewbourne Oil Company, (OGRID No. 14744) (“Applicant”) applies for an order pooling all uncommitted interests in the Bone Spring formation underlying a 942.24-acre, more or less, standard horizontal spacing unit comprised of Lots 25–32 of irregular Section 5, and Lots 13, 14 and 29–34 of irregular Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, and Lots 13, 14, 27–30, and the N/2 SW/4 of irregular Section 1, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, Eddy County, New Mexico (“Unit”). In support of its application, Mewbourne states the following.

1. Applicant is a working interest owner in the Unit and has the right to drill wells thereon.
2. The Unit will be dedicated to the **Ophelia 5/1 Fed Com #625H** well (“Well”), which will be drilled from a surface hole location in Lot 29 of irregular Section 5, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, to a bottom hole location in the NW/4 SW/4 (Unit L) of irregular Section 1, Township 21 South, Range 25 East.
3. The completed interval of the Well will be orthodox.
4. The completed interval of the Well will be located within 330’ of the quarter-quarter section line separating Lots 25–28 from Lots 29–32 of irregular Section 5, the quarter-quarter section line separating Lots 13, 14 and 29–30 from Lots 31–34 of irregular Section 6, Township 21 South, Range 26 East, and the quarter-quarter section line separating Lots 13, 14 and

27–28 from Lots 29–30 and the N/2 SW/4 of irregular Section 1, Township 21 South, Range 25 East, to allow for the creation of a 942.24-acre standard horizontal spacing unit.

5. Applicant has undertaken diligent, good faith efforts to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners to participate in the drilling of the Well but has been unable to obtain voluntary agreements from all interest owners.

6. The pooling of uncommitted interests will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste, and protect correlative rights.

7. In order to allow Applicant to obtain its just and fair share of the oil and gas underlying the subject lands, all uncommitted interests in the Unit should be pooled and Applicant should be designated the operator of the Well and the Unit.

WHEREFORE, Applicant requests that this application be set for hearing before an Examiner of the Oil Conservation Division on July 9, 2026, and, after notice and hearing as required by law, the Division enter an order:

- A. Pooling all uncommitted interests in the Unit;
- B. Approving the Well in the Unit;
- C. Designating Applicant as operator of the Unit and the Well to be drilled thereon;
- D. Authorizing Applicant to recover its costs of drilling, equipping and completing the Well;
- E. Approving the actual operating charges and costs of supervision while drilling and after completion, together with a provision adjusting the rates pursuant to the COPAS accounting procedures; and

- F. Imposing a 200% penalty for the risk assumed by Applicant in drilling and completing the Well against any working interest owner who does not voluntarily participate in the drilling of the Well.
