NOW, on this 6th day of May, 1971, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Wolfson Oil Company, seeks approval of a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the SW/4, S/2 NW/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to its Cities-Federal Well No. 1 located 2310 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of said Section 20.
- (3) That the entire non-standard proration unit is productive of gas from the Jalmat Gas Pool and that the entire non-standard proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by said Cities-Federal Well No. 1.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce itr just and equitable share of the gas in the Jalmat Gas Pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the

augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit in the Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the SW/4, S/2 NW/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and dedicated to the Wolfson Oil Company Cities-Federal Well No. 1, located 2310 feet from the South line and 330 feet from the West line of said Section 20.
- (2) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.



The above captioned well was filed in the Eunice, South, Seven Rivers, Queen Field and was drilled to a total depth of 3800 feet.

Possible producing zones in the Eunice, South Field from 3767 - 3790 were periorated, acidized, and found non-productive.

Possible producing zones in the Jalmat oil zone from 3498-3508 were perforated, acidized, and found non-productive.

The well was plugged back to the Jalmat gas zone and perforated from 3222 - 3442 and completed as a gas well. In as much as the location is only 330' from the West line, we respectfully request an approval for a non-standard gas location.

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Wolfson Oil Company, seeks approval of a 280-acre non-standard gas proration unit comprising the SW/4, S/2 NW/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to its 1550 feet from the North-line Cities-Federal Well No. 1 located in Unit of oaid.

- (3) That the entire non-standard proration unit is productive of gas from the Secretarion and that the entire non-standard proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by said Cities-Federal Well No. 1.
- (4) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Jalmat Gas Pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wells, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- Jalmat Gas Pool comprising the SW/4, S/2 NW/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 20, Township 22 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, is hereby established and dedicated to the Wolfson Oil Company Cities-Federal Well No. 1, located in Unit Of said Section 20.
