Please consider this our formal application for an Order of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division force-pooling all of the mineral interests in the Dakcta formation underlying the South Half (S/2) of Section 18, Township 30 North, Range 14 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, to be dedicated to a well to be drilled at a standard location thereon.

More specifically, Dugan Production Corp., as the applicant, requests an Order of the New Mexico Cil Conservation Division designating Dugan Production Corp. as the Operator of the proposed well. allowing Dugan Production Corp. to recover the cost of drilling, completing and operating the proposed well, together with an additional 200% of such costs for the risk factor involved in drilling the well, and establishing a reasonable charge for the supervision of the proposed well during the drilling and production stages.
