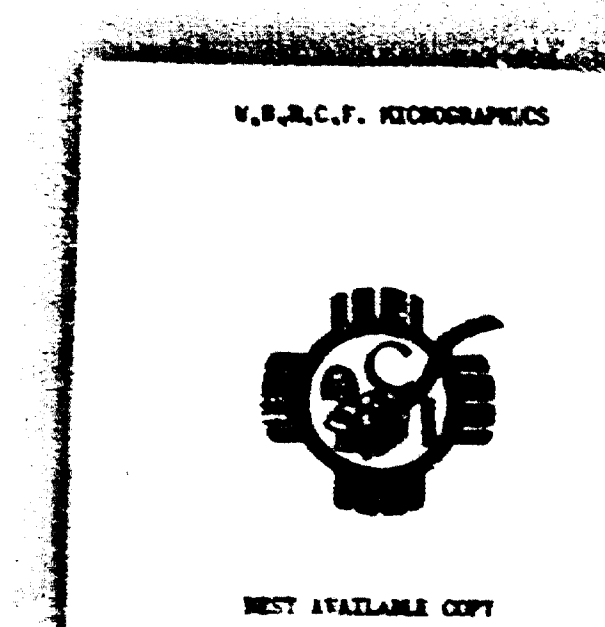

ORDER OF THE DIVISION

BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on September 5,  
1979, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Richard L. Stenets  
Now, on this day of September, 1979, the Division  
Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the  
recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the  
premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by  
law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject  
matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Exxon Corporation,  
seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well  
location 1668 feet from the South line  
and 1450 feet from the West line of Section  
31, Township 20 South, Range 3 East  
N44W, E2E, Cimarron Gas Pool, Lea  
County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant further seeks to  
simultaneously dedicate the W/4 of said  
Section 31 to the above described well and  
to its Piggies State Well No. 4 located  
in Unit #1 of said Section 31.

(4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better  
enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.

(5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox  
location and simultaneous dedication.
