TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. UTZ: We will proceed to Case 1579.

MR. PAYNE: Case, 1579, "Application of Amerada Petroleum Corporation for a dual completion."

MR. KELLAHIN: Jason Kellahin, Kellahin and Fox, Santa Fe, New Mexico, representing the applicant.

We have the same witness that appeared in the preceding case, Mr. Broschat.

RICHARD E. BROSCHAT

called as a witness, having first been duly sworn, testified as follows:

BY MR. KELLAHIN:

- Q State your name, please?
- A My name is Richard E. Broschat.
- Q You are the same Mr. Broschat who testified in Case 1578?
 - A Yes, sir.
- Q Are you familiar with the application in Case 1579, Mr. Broschat?
 - A Yes, I am.
 - Q What is proposed to be done in that application?

A In Case Number 1579, we propose to dually complete the Fred Turner, Junior Number 2 in such a way as to produce this well from the McKee and the Connell formations through parallel strings of 2 1/16 inch tubing.

(Whereupon, the documents were marked as Applicant's Exhibits One, Two and Three for identification).

Q (By Mr. Kellahin) Referring to what has been marked as Exhibit Number One, will you state what that shows?

A Exhibit Number One is a map of a portion of the Warren-McKee field. It shows the subject well, the Fred Turner, Junior Number Two, circled in red, it shows the location of the offset wells and lease ownership in that area.

Q Referring to what has been marked as Exhibit Number Two, would you state what that is?

A Exhibit Number Two is a diagramatic sketch of the proposed dual completion. It shows the casing program, 13 3/8 inch casing set at 296 feet, 8 5/8 intermediate set at 3710 feet and 5 1/2 inch casing set at 9270 feet. It shows the perforations in the McKee formation from 8996 to 9085 feet and the perforations in the Connell from 9,245 feet to 9,263 feet and a Baker Model "D" production packer set at 9100 feet, and again we will have two parallel strings of 2 1/16 inch tubing.

MR. UTZ: Hydrill tubing, isn't it?

- A Hydrill, yes sir.
- Q (By Mr. Kellahin) In this well, is the McKee formation flowing?
 - A The McKee formation is flowing.
- Q How about the Connell, do you have any information on it?
 - A We anticipate that the Connell will flow also.
- Q Now, do you have any pressure information on the two zones. Mr. Broschat?
- A Yes, we have. In this well, the bottomhole pressure in the McKee, run on May 15, 1958, was 1,026 PSI at a minus 5500, and we did run a bottomhole pressure in the Connell and we got 3474 PSI at a minus 5700 feet.
- Q Do you have any information on the gravities of the fluids of the two formations?
 - A The gravity of the McKee is 44 degrees, and the only

test that we have on the Connell as far as the gravity is concerned was the drill stem test back in 1953, I believe, and got a gravity of 54 degrees.

Q Do you have any information on the type of crude in the two formations?

A The McKee, of course, is a sweet crude, and we have no information on the Connell.

Q Is this type of completion which you are proposing, in your opinion, adequate to protect the two formations, communication between the two?

A Yes, it is.

Q Is the type of completion proposed such that it will permit you to make any tests that may be required by the Commission?

A Yes, it will.

Q Are you willing to make such tests?

A Yes. sir.

Q In your opinion, is this in the interests of conservation and the protection of the two formations?

A Yes sir, it is.

Q Do you have a log of the subject well?

A Yes, I have a log of the subject well, the Fred Turner, Junior Number 2, on which the perforations have been marked.

MR. KELLAHIN: I would like to have that marked as Exhibit Number Three.

(Whereupon, the document was marked as Applicant's Exhibit

Number Three for identification).

- (By Mr. Kellahin) You say the perforations have been marked on the two zenes?
 - A Yes, the perforations on the two zones have been marked.
- Were Exhibits One, Two and Three prepared by you or under your direction or supervision?

A Yes, sir.

MR. KELLAHIN: At this time, we would like to offer in evidence Exhibits One, Two and Three.

MR. UTZ: Without objection, Exhibits One, Two and Three will be accepted.

MR. KELLAHIN: That's all the questions we have.

MR. UTZ: Are there questions of the witness?

MR. FISCHER: You say the McKee will flow?

A The McKee is flowing at the present time.

MR. FISCHER: And the Connell?

A We anticipate that it will flow.

MR. FISCHER: If you did have to put a pump on the Connell, what type of pump do you think you would put on there, Mr. Broschat?

A It would be a conventional beam-type pumping unit.

MR. FISCHER: All right. And I will ask the same question as before, will the tubing be bull plugged or run in a cage?

A We will run a cage in there.

MR. FISCHER: That's all the questions I have, thank you.

MR. UTZ: Any other questions of the witness?

If not, the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused).

MR. UTZ: Are there other statements to be made in this case?

If not, the case will be taken under advisement.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on January 7, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Elvis A. Utz, Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," in accordance with Pule 1214 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

NOW, on this day of January, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the evidence adduced and the recommendations of the Examiner, Elvis A. Utz, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, is the owner and operator of the Turner No. 2 Well, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (3) That the applicant proposes to dually complete the above-described Turner No. 2 Well in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Warren-McKee Pool and the production of cil from an undesignated Connell Pool through parallel strings of 2-1/16 inch Hydril tubing.
- (4) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and in accord with good conservation practices.
- (5) That approval of the subject application will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

-2-Case No. 1579 Order No. R-1323

(6) That the subject application should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Amerada Petroleum Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Turner No. 2 Well, located 1980 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 17, Township 20 South, Range 38 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from the Warren-McKee Pool and the production of oil from an undesignated Connell Pool through parallel strings of 2-1/16 inch Hydril tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Gas-Oil Ratio Test Period for the Warren-McKee Pool.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-some production in the interests of conservation.






