All of sections 32 and 33

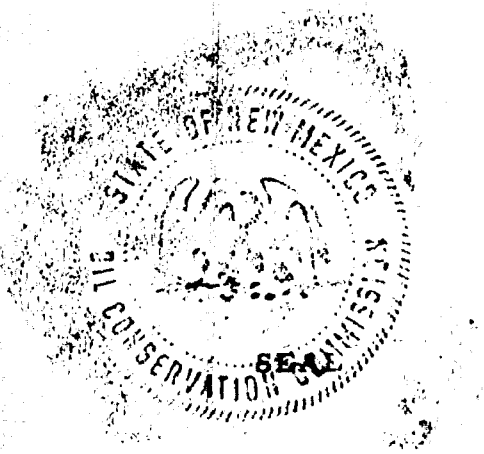
