ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause come on for hearing at 9 o'clock a. m. July 15, 1952, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this <sup>±4</sup>5 day of August, 1952, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM  
E/2 Section 29

(3) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:

Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM  
S/2 Section 17, SE/4 Section 18

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission be, and the same hereby is approved, as follows:

(1) That the boundaries of the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 27 North, Range 11 West, NMPM  
E/2 Section 29

(2) That the boundaries of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, San Juan County, New Mexico, be and the same hereby are extended to include:

Township 30 North, Range 10 West, NMPM  
S/2 Section 17, SE/4 Section 18

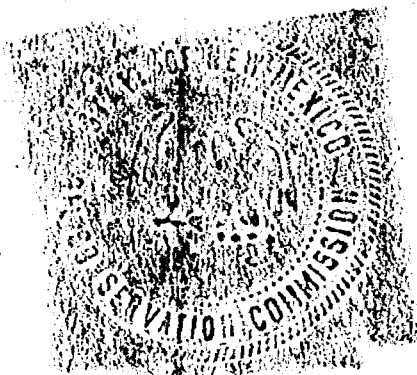
