Q Would you state your name, please?

A Victor E. Lyon.

Q By whom are you employed and in what position, Mr. Lyon?

A I work for Continental Oil Company as Conservation Coordinator in the Hobbs Division Office located in Hobbs, New Mexico.

Q Have you ever testified before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico and had your qualifications made a matter of record? A Yes, I have.

MR. KELLAHIN: Are the Witness' qualifications acceptable?

MR. STAMETS: They are,

BY MR. KELLAHIN:

Q Mr. Lyon, are you familiar here with the Application of Continental Oil Company in Case 5414?

A Yes, sir.

Q What is proposed by the Applicant in this Case?

A Case 5414 is the Application of Continental Oil Company for approval of a non-standard location for its Meyer B-28 Acct. 2, No. 3, and for authority to jointly allocate the existing 360-acre non-standard proration unit to Wells Nos. 2 and 3 which are located inside that Unit.

Q What would the Unit consist of?

A The Unit consists of the Southeast Quarter, the East Half of the Southwest Quarter of Section 28, the North Half of the Northeast Quarter and the Northeast Quarter Northwest Quarter, Section 33, Township 20 South, Range 37 East.

Q Referring to what has been marked as Exhibit No. 1, does that show the proposed unit and the location of the subject wells? A Yes, it does. The existing unit, which was previously created by order of the Commission, is shown outlined in red as I previously described, and the two wells, Nos. 2 and 3 are shown circled in red. No. 2, which was the original well for this unit, is located in the approximate center of Unit 0, that is the Southwest Quarter Southeast Quarter of Section 28. The new well, No. 3, is shown in Unit C at a location 760 feet from the north line and 1880 feet from the west line in Section 33. The original location for this well was 660 feet from the north line and 1980 from the west line, but this location was too close to a gas pipeline and it was necessary to move it to the location on which it was drilled.

Q Now, as I understand, the non-standard unit has already been approved for your Well No. 2, is that correct?

A Yes.

Q And you're asking for approval of the same unit for your Well No. 3 and the simultaneous dedication?

A Yes, sir. This area has been communitized and the additional well is needed to increase the productivity of the proration unit.

Q Could you give us some information on the status

of the two wells?

A Well No. 2 has been declining in productivity; it was classified marginal in July of 1970. The No. 3 Well was spudded on December 23rd, 1974, and has been completed and is-- I believe it is connected to the gas gathering system but it is not producing because it does not have an allowable.

Q Do you have anything to add?

A We would like authority to produce the allowable assigned to the unit between the two wells in any proportion. Q Was Exhibit No. 1 prepared by you or under your supervision?

A Yes, it was.

MR. KELLAHIN: At this time I would like to offer Exhibit No. 1.

NOW, on this day of February , 1975, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Continuated Callerapproval, seeks the approval for a non-standard 360-acre gas proration unit comprising the SE/4 and E/2 SW/4 of Section 28, and the N/2 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 33, both in Township 20 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

(3) That the applicant seeks to simultaneously dedicate to

said non-standard unit its Meyer B-28 A Com Acct. 2 Wells Nos. 2 and 3 located, respectively, Ain Unit of Section 28 and in Unit of said Section 33, with unit production to be taken from said wells in any proportion.

(4) That the proposed non-standard gas proration unit can be efficiently and economically drained and developed by the subject wells.

(5) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable share of the gas in the Eumont Gas Pool and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That effective at 7:00 a.m. <u>April 1975</u>, the applicant, Continental Oil Company, is hereby authorized to a simultaneously dedicate its non-standard 360-acre gas proration unit comprising the SE/4 and E/2 SW/4 of Section 28, and the N/2 NE/4 and NE/4 NW/4 of Section 33, both in Township 26 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Eumont Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, to its Meyer B-28 A Com Acct. 2 Wells Nos. 2 and 3 located, *stunorth.dor toutron* respectively, in Unit *C* of said Section 28 and in Unit Cof said Section 33, with unit production to be taken from said wells in any proportion.

(2) That the allowable **produ** assigned to the above-described gas proration unit shall be based upon the unit size of 360 acres and that the operator may produce the allowable assigned to the unit from the subject wells in any proportion.

(3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary. DONE at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on the day and year hereinabove

designated.
