Mobil_Oil Corporation wishes to protest the Burleson & Huff Application to dispose of produced water into Rustler formation from approximately 937' to 1200' in its Arco Well No. 2. The water flow problem being experienced a few miles north and in several areas of Lea County indicate a need for caution in pressuring up a shallow interval, where migration behind casing strings may be possible.] A few miles south, the Texas regulatory authorities require protection of the Santa Rosa fresh water sand at a depth of 600' and will not permit injection into the Rustler formation which is at a depth of about 900'. Mobil Oil believes that this shallow injection should not be permitted as applied for.




Gentlemen:

The Burleson & Huff Arco No. 2 well is situated 1980 from the north and 330 from the east lines of Section 21, T-25-S, R-37-E, Lea County, New Mexico. The well was spudded on November 4, 1975 and was to have been drilled to a depth of about 3500 feet to test the Queen formation; however, at a depth of about 1056 feet circulation was lost. The well was dry drilled to a depth of 1250 feet, and then further drilling was abandoned as circulation was never restored after repeated attempts were made to do so. The well is presently temporarily abandoned.

Burleson & Huff hereby makes application to convert its Arco No. 2 well to a water disposal well. If approved, the disposal well will be used to dispose of water produced from various wells in this area where such water is mineralized to such a degree as to be unfit for domestic, stock, irrigation and/or other general use. As shown on the attached diagrametic sketch the injection of produced water will be made into the Rustler formation at a depth of about 937 feet.

The <u>Rustler</u> is an older formation than the Triassic formation. The <u>Rustler formation</u> in this area is known to carry highly salty water which is unfit for domestic, stock, irrigation and/or general use. None of the wells within two miles of the proposed injection well produce from the Rustler formation. Applicant hereby asks for administrative approval of this application without notice and hearing as an exception to Rule 701-A.

After abandoning the No. 2 well Burleson & Huff skidded the rig and drilled its No. 2-Y well situated 1770 feet from the north and 660 feet from the east lines of said Section 21. Enclosed are three copies of log on the No. 2-Y well (the replacement well) together with three copies of this application, application form C-108, diagrametic sketch and plat of the surrounding area.


