Gentlemen:

Morris R. Antweil respectfully requests a hearing to consider the force pooling of 320 acres, being the S/2 of Section 33, T21S-R26E, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, as to all hydrocarbon production from the Pennsylvanian formation.

The acreage within the area proposed to be pooled is held as follows:

We wrote to Superior on 2 August and requested that they join us in the drilling of an 11,400-foot Morrow test at a standard location in the S/2 of Section 33. Superior has indicated that it will take them until at least October 1976 to respond to our request. We are interested in the early development of our leasehold to meet the offsets of Hanagan Petroleum in the N/2 of Section 33-T21S-R26E and Superior in the W/2 of Section 34-T21S-R26E. The Superior No. 1 State Q, the east offset to our proposed gas spacing and proration unit, is currently producing 1.8 MMCFPD from the Morrow.
