FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That Juanita Frank is the owner and operator of the Greathouse Frank Well No. 2, located in Unit C of Section 10, Township 23 North, Range I West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.
- (3) That The Aetna Casualty and Surety Company is the surety on the Oil Conservation Commission plugging bond on which Juanita Frank is principal.
- (4) That the purpose of said bond is to assure the state that the subject well will be properly plugged and abandoned when not capable of commercial production.
- (5) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said Greathouse Frank Well No. 2 should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on or before December 1, 1976, or the well should be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.

September of 1974 they filed an Intent to Change Flans to change the casing size they intended to run. In March of 1975 a letter from the Commission office to the operators requested information and the status of the well.
