FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof;
- (2) That there is need for certain extensions to the Atoka Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the Atoka Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

All of Section 14
W/2 Section 15
NW/4 of Section 22


