### ORDER OF THE CONMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 ofclock W.m. on August 13, 1958, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinefter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 1/2 day of August, 1958, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the scention of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of oll from the Gallup formation, said pool to bear the designation Gallegos-Gallup Oll Pool. Said Gallegos-Gallup Oll Peol was discovered by Skelly Oll Company's Navajo "B" Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 SE/4 Section 14, Township 26 North, Range 12 West, HMPM. It was completed September 15, 1954. The top of the perforations is at 5010 feet.

(3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Aztes-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Bisti-Lower Gallup Dil Pool, and the Horseshoe-Gallup Oll Pool, all in Sam Juan County, New Mexico, to the Tapacite-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Escrite-Gallup Oll Pool, and the South Blanco-Tocito Oll Pool, all In Rio Arribe County, New Mexico, and to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Messverde Pool, both in Sam Juan and Rio Arribe Counties, New Mexico.

## MR. PORTER: We will take up Case 1490.

ER. PAYEE: Northwestern New Mexico nomenclatuee case calling for an order for the creation of a new pool and the extension of existing pools in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

A. KENDRICKS,

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn on oath, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PAYNE:

Q Will the witness please state his name and position?

A A. Kendricks, engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission. Q Mc. Kendricks, in your capacity with the Oil Conservation Commission, have you had an opportunity to make a study concerning the desirability of the creation of new pools and extension of existing pools in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico?

A I have.

Q What are your recommendations concerning the creation of a new oil pool for Gallup production?

A I recommend a new oil pool be created in San Juan County, known as the Gallegos-Gallup Oil Pool; that the horizontal limits be extended as advertised; vertical limits be the Gallup formation; based on the discovery well, being the Skelley Oil Company's No. 1 Navajo "B", located in unit "I" of 14, 26 North, 12 West, initial

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potential of 3,500 MOF per day, shutin casing pressure 1,400 pounds after fourteen hours. It was completed 9/15/54. The top of perforations was at 5,010 feet. There are seventy-seven wells cuvrently capable of producing from this pool; from this Gallup formation.

Q Mat are your recommendations concerning extension of the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I-recommend the Aztec-Pictured Cliff's Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing from the t pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of thirteen wells capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool?

A I recommend the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Blanco Mesaverde Pool?

A I recommend the Blanco Mesaverde Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of four wells capable of producing from that pool.

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What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool be entended as advertised on the basis of two wells capable of producing.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Ascrito-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend the Escrito-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool?

A I recommend the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool?

A I recommend the South Blanco-Tocite Oil Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of one well capable of producing from that pool.

Q Mr. Kendricks, have you prepared Exhibits substantiating your recommendations?

A Yes, I have two Exhibits. I have one Exhibit drawn up In the order of an advertisement except it shows the wells capable of producing in the individual pools. I have, as a second Exhibit, a proposed order for the Commission's consideration in this case. Q Now, are these Exhibits designated 1 and 2?

A They will be.

Q Mr. Kendricks, what was the top of the perforation on the discovery well on the Gallegos-Gallup Pool?

A Five thousand and ten feet.

Q And this pool will receive a depth factor for the five to six thousand range, is that correct?

A That is correct.

MR. NUTTER: Thank you.

MR. PORTER: Any further questions? The witness may be excused.

(Witness excused)

MR. PORTER: Anyone have anything to add in this case, any further testimony?

We will take the case under advisement, and the hearing is adjourned.
