FINDS:

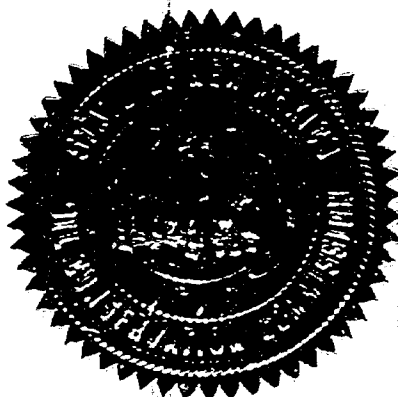
(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

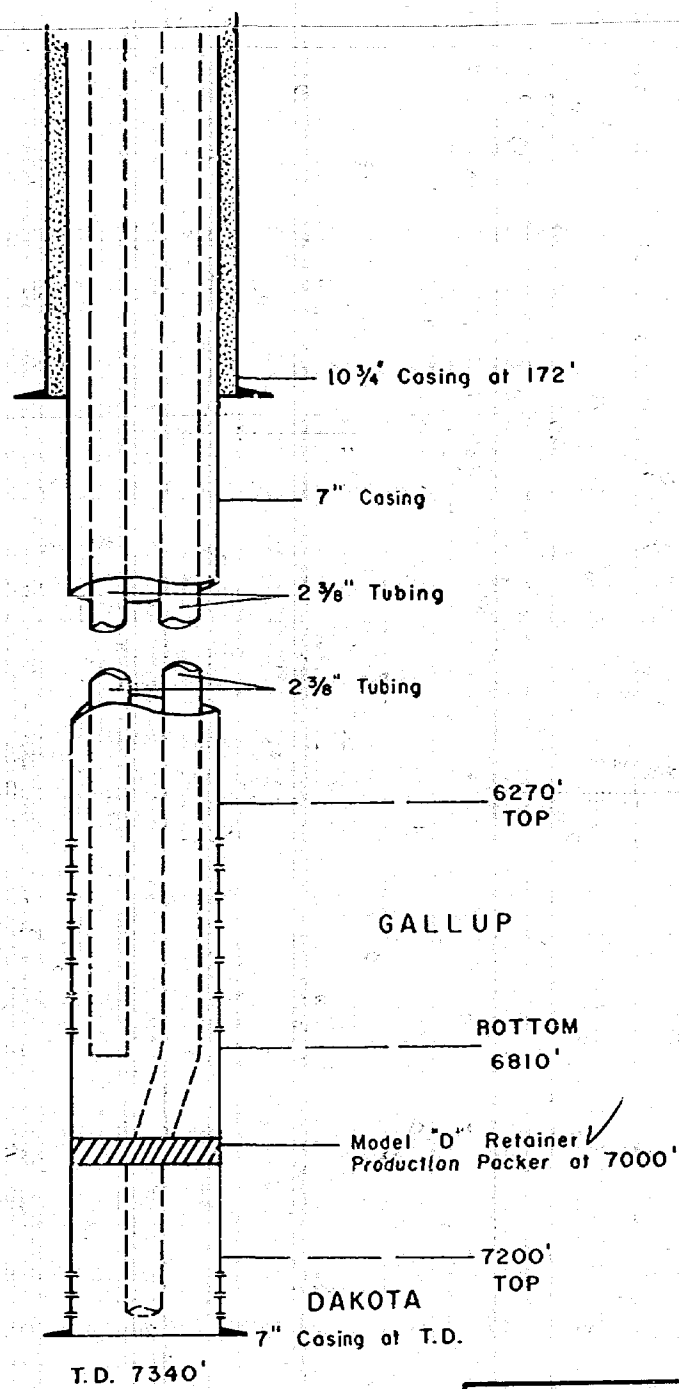

NE/4 NE/4 SEC. II, T 24 N - R 4 W

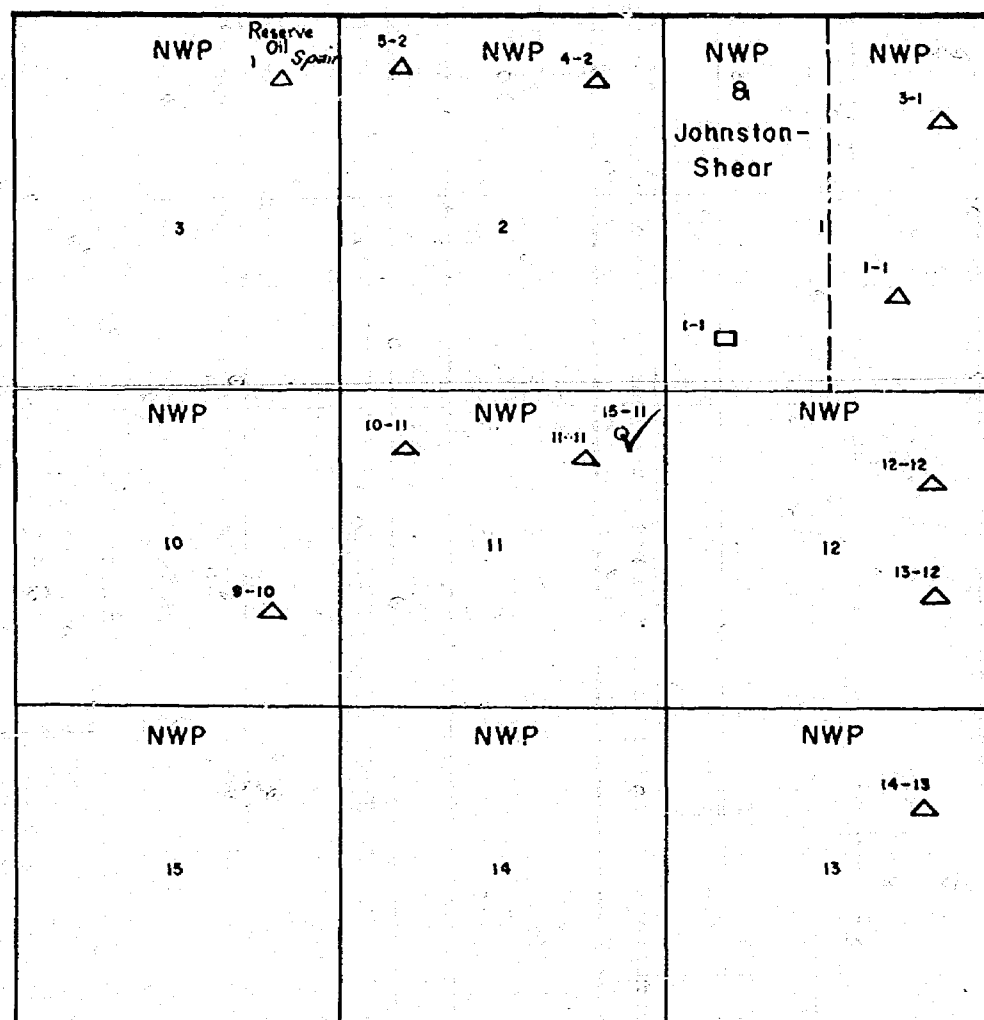
