ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on September 16, 1959, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, herinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this and day of September, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully edvised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to bear the designation Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said Baish-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, M. E. Baish "A" Well No. 27, located in the SE/4 of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East, NMPM. It was completed June 15, 1959. The top of perforations is at 10,726 feet.
- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Brushy Canyon formation, said pool to bear the designation Cotton Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool. Said Cotton Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool was discovered by Texaco, Inc., Heflin Federal Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 24, Township 24 South, Range 31 East, No. 1 It was completed in Brushy Canyon formation June 22, 1959. The top of perforations is at 7184 feet.

- (4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Devonian formation, said pool to bear the designation King Camp-Devonian Pool. Said King Camp-Devonian Pool was discovered by the British American Oil Producing Company, Honolulu Federal Well No. 1, located in the NE/4 of Section 27, Township 14 South, Range 29 East, NMPM. It was completed July 21, 1959. The top of perforations is at 10,222 feet.
- (5) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Tubb formation, said pool to bear the designation Weir-Tubb Gas Pool. Said Weir-Tubb Gas Pool was discovered by Continental Oil Company, Britt B-15 Well No. 9, located in the SE/4 of Section 15, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, Norm. It was completed April 24, 1959. The top of perforations is at 6474 feet.
- (6) That there is need for certain extensions to the Little Lucky-Lake Devonian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico; and to Robinson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico; and to the Bishop Canyon Pool, the Four Lakes-Devonian Gas Pool, the Jalmat Gas Pool, the Justis Drinkard Pool, the Maljamar Pool, the Roberts Pool, the Skaggs Pool, the Teas Pool, and the Wilson Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. PAYNE:

- Q Will the witness please state his name and position?
- A R. F. Montgomery, proration manager for New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q Mr. Montgomery, in your official capacity with the Oil Conservation Commission, have you made a study concerning the necessity or desirability for creating and extending existing pools in Eddy and Lea Counties, New Mexico?
 - A I have.
- Q What are your recommendations concerning creation of a new oil pool for Rennsylvanian production?

A It is my recommendation that we create the Baish-Pennsylvanian Oil Pool; horizontal limits be the SE/4 of Section 21, Township 17 South, Range 32 East. The top of the perforations was 10,726 feet.

- A The Pennsylvanian formation.
- Q What are your recommendations concerning creation of a new oil pool for Brushy Canyon?

as the Cotton Draw-Brushy Canyon Pool. Discovery well in this pool was the Texaco, Inc. - Heflin Federal Well No. 1 located in Unit O of Section 24, Township 24, South, Range 31 East. 
