As per our telephone conversation today with Mr. Joe Ramey with the Oil Conservation Commission in Hobbs, New Mexico, we honorably request permission to commingle our No. 3-G Walker located in the <u>Maljamar Yates Pool</u> with our present wells No. 1 and No. 2 that are producing from the <u>Pearsall</u> zone.
