APPLICATION

COMES NOW The British American Oil Producing Company and respectfully alleges and states as follows:

- 1. That it is organize of the Salge "B", Bouchie "B" Mary, Marye" B", Salge and Navajo leases which are productive of oil from the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, the production from which is subject to restriction pursuant to Order No. R-1427, dated June 25, 1959, which provides among other things, that no casinghead gas shall be flared or vented from any well in said pool after December 31, 1959.
- 2. That applicant, aware of the importance of conserving produced casinghead gas, installed a gas gathering system at a cost of \$162,000 upon the aforementioned leases in the western portion of said oil pool and commenced injection of said produced casinghead gas on March 13, 1959, before order No. R-1427 was issued, and since that time has injected and conserved a total of 246,000 mcf of casinghead gas.
- 3. That increasing oil-gas ratios have now resulted in production of approximately 2,400 mcf of gas per day from said leases, of which the aforesaid facilities can handle only 1,226 MCFD and 221 MCFD are consumed in lease operations and that applicant previously arranged with EJ. Paso Natural Gas Company to take all of said casinghead gas prior to January 1, 1960.
- 4. That applicant is now advised by El Paso Natural Cas Company that the field facilities being constructed by said company for handling

in and

such gas will not be completed before January 15, or February 1, 1960.

- 5. That applicant, as aforesaid, at substantial cost, installed said gas gathering and injection system as soon as possible after the first hearing held by this Commission on December 17, 1958, although not required to do so, and as a result has conserved great quantities of casinghead gas.
- 6. That due to no fault of its own, applicant is now faced with a delay of some fifteen to thirty days in disposal of all of its gas in accordance with said order, and consequent restriction of production from its leases, which will cause undue hardship upon applicant, which has heretofore exhibited prudence and diligence in its field operations.
 - 7. That by reason of the foregoing, an emergency exists.

WHEREFORE, applicant prays for administrative approval of an exception to said order, pursuant to provisions thereof, until said field facilities of El Paso Natural Gas C ompany are completed and in operation; and in the alternative, should this Commission see fit not to grant such administrative exception, applicant prays for issuance of an emergency order pursuant to Rule 12/2 of this Commission, granting an exception to said Order No. 1427, as it applies to applicants leases named herein, and setting said matter for hearing before this Commission during the time said emergency order is in force.


