What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the Justis-McKee Pool?

It is recommended that the Justis-McKee Pool boundary be extended as shown in paragraph (n), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed therein.

What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the East Millman-Queen-Grayburg Pool?

It is recommended that the boundary be extended as shown in paragraph (o), Exhibit 1, on the basis of two wells completed therein.

0 What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the East Millman-Seven Rivers Pool?

It is recommended that the East Millman-Seven Rivers Pool boundary be extended as shown in paragraph (p), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed therein.

What are your recommendations concerning the extension or the South Paddock Pool?

It is recommended that the South Paddock Pool boundary be extended as shown in paragraph (q), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed therein.

What are your recommendations concerning the extension of the South Vacuum-Devonian Pool?



It is recommended that the South Vacuum-Devonian Pool be extended as shown in paragraph (r), Exhibit 1, on the basis of one well completed therein.
