FINDS:

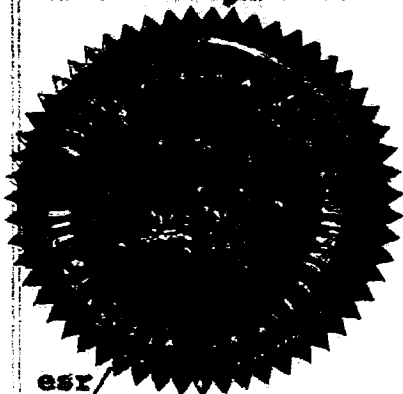
(1) That due public notice having been given as required by


