ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION

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This cause came on for bearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 13, 1961, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Gil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, bereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 17 th day of July, 1961, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said bearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is most for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Sam Andres formation, said pool to hear the designation Bunice-Sam Andres Pool. Suid Eunice-Sam Andres Pool was discovered by Secony Nebil Oil Company, R. O. Carson Well No. 23, located in the W/2 HE/4 and E/2 HM/4 of Section 33, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, HMPM. It was completed February 24, 1961. The depth to casing shoe is at 4100 feet.

(3) That there is most for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Hexido, for the production of oil from the Queen formation, said pool to bear the designation Querecho Plains-Queen Pool. Said Querecho Plains-Queen Pool was discovered by Santiago Oil and Gas Company, Texado Federal Well No. 1-A, located in the NE/4 of Section 34, Township 18 South, Range 32 Hast, MRPM. It was completed April 25, 1961. The top of perforations is at 4056 feet. -2-CASE No. 2337 Order No. R-2034

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(4) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Pennsylvanian formation, said pool to hear the designation Squyres-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said Squyres-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Campana Petroleum Company, Federal C Well No. 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 10, Township 7 South, Range 32 East, MMPM. It was completed April 18, 1961. The top of perforations is at 8380 feet.

(5) That there is need for certain extensions to the South Bitter Lake-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, to the Getty Pool and the West Henshaw-Grayburg Pool, both in Eddy County, New Mexico, and to the Langlie-Mattix Pool, the Lazy J Pool, the Pearl-Queen Pool, the Robinson Pool, the Morth Square Lake-Grayburg Pool, and the Vacuum-Abo Pool, all in Les County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for San Andres production, he and the same is hereby created and designated as the Eunice-San Andres Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(b) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Queen production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Querecho Plains-Queen Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

(c) That a new pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production, he and the same is hereby created and designated as the Squyres-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

Q In your present capacity, Mr. Ramey, have you determined that the Commission should create and extend certain pools in Southeastern, New Mexico?

A Yes.

Q What is your recommendation concerning the creation of a new pool for San Andres production?

A It is recommended that a new pool be created and designated as the Eunice-San Andres Pool.
