### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on for hearing at 10 o'clock A. M. on the 22nd day of November, 1949 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this <u>22nd</u> day of <u>November</u>, 1949, the Commission, having before it for consideration the testimony adduced at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

1. That due public notice having been given, as provided by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause.

2. That the acreage involved in the Application is Federally owned and the Supervisor of the United States

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Geolog' 11 Survey interposes no objections to the Applica-

tion.

3. That the leases covering the following de-

scribed land are owned by Danciger Oil & Refining Company:

TURNER "A" LEASE, Las Cruces Serial No. 029395(a) described as SE/4, Lots 3 and 4 and E/2 SW/4 Section 18; NE/4, Lots 1 and 2 and E/2 NW/4 Section 19, Township 17 South; Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., in Eddy County, New Mexico, and containing 609.43 acres, more or less.

TURNER "B" LEASE, Las Cruces Serial No. 029395(b) described as S/2 S/2, NW/4 SW/4 Section 17; All Section 20; All Section 29; Lots 3 and 4, SE/4 and E/2 SW/4 Section 30, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., in Eddy County, New Mexico, and containing 1786.15 acres, more or less.

4. That from inception of production on the Turner "A" Lease, which occurred on or about March 1, 1930, up to the present time, there have been drilled a total of twenty-two producing wells; that fourteen of said wells are producing from the Grayburg Gin", encountered at an approximate depth of 3400 feet; that the remaining eight wells on the Turner "A" Lease are producing from the Seven Pivers Sand, encountered at an approximate depth of 1870 feet.

5. That from inception of production on the Turner "B" Lease, which occurred on or about November 21, 1938, there have been drilled a total of twenty-nine producing wells; that ten of said wells are producing from the Grayburg Lime, encountered at an approximate depth of 3400 feet; that Well No. 1 on the Turner "B" Lease is producing from the Premier Sand, encountered at an approximate

depth of 3100 feet, and the eighteen remaining wells on the Turner "B" Lease are producing from the Seven Rivers Send, encountered at a depth renging from 1885 feet to a depth of 2180 feet. That at the present time Well No. 30, located in the Center of the SE/4 SE/4 Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, is drilling or is in the process of being completed.

6. That one well located on a forty acre legal subdivision is not sufficient to obtain all of the recoverable oil from the Grayburg Lime under any such forty acre tract, and that the drilling of "five spot" wells, as proposed in the Application of Danciger Oil & Refining Company, at the locations designated, would be in the interest of conservation, prevent waste and enable Applicant to obtain a greater ultimate recovery of oil, in that Applicant would be able to recover substantial quantities of oil which would otherwise not be produced if such "five spot" locations were not drilled.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION That the Application of Danciger Oil & Refining Company for an order granting permits to drill the twelve unorthodox "five spot" locations, to be completed in the Grayburg Lime, described in said Application, be and the same are hereby granted and approved. The numbers and locations of the wells to be drilled being, as follows:

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TURNER "A", Well No. 24: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1280 feet East of the West Line and 1280 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 25: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2560 feet East of the West Line and 1280 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A" Well No. 26: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet West of the East Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A" Well No. 27: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 28: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2665 feet East of the West Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 29: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1295 feet West of the East Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 30: Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 975 feet South of the North Line;

TURNER "A", Well No. 31: Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2665 feet East of the West Line and 975 feet South of the North Line;

TURNER "B", Well No. 31: Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 1085 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 S/2 of Section 17;

TURNER "B", Well No. 32: Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2665 feet East of the West Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 S/2 of Section 17;

TURNER "B", Well No. 33: Section 17, Township 17 South, Renge 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1295 feet West of the East Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 S/2 of Section 17;

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TURNER "B", Well No. 34: Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1295 feet West of the East Line and 1295 feet Scuth of the North Line;

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That Danciger Oil & Refining Company shall not be obligated to drill all twelve of such locations, it being understood that the data and information obtained from the drilling of the first of such "five spot" locations may cause Applicant to desire to change or modify its future program with reference to the drilling of all twelve unorthodox locations hereinabove described.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That in instances where any of the proposed "five spot" wells to be drilled constitute a second well upon a legal forty acre subdivision that Danciger Oil & Refining Company shall only be permitted to produce from the two such wells producing from the Grayburg Lime located upon such forty acre legal subdivision, the allowable as fixed by the Oil Conservation Commission for the forty acre proration unit upon which said two wells are located and in no event shall the combined daily production from the two Grayburg Lime wells located upon any forty acre is gal subdivision exceed the allowable for Grayburg Lime production as fixed by the Oil Conservation Commission for such forty acre proration unit.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED BY THE COMMISSION, That the Applicant shall file with the Commission copy of

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Federal Location Notice for each of the hereinabove described locations, after approval thereof by the Oil and Gas Supervisor.

No encroachment of outer boundaries of either leasehold is involved, as each of the above stated proposed locations would be at least 1085 feet from the nearest leaso boundary.

No objection is offered by this office to the well spacing plan providing for drilling of 12 wells et locations specified in the application to test the producing reservoir of the Jackson pool. The drilling of these wells may afford opportunity for additional recovery of oil and gas from the producing reservoir. Approval to drill the wells will be contingent upon approval of the unorthodox locations for proration purposes by the Oil Conservation Commission of the State of New Mexico.

4. That from inception of production on the Turner "B" Lease, which occurred on or about November 21, 1938, there have been drilled a total of twenty-nine producing wells; that ten of said wells are producing from the Grayburg Lime, encountered at an approximate depth of 3400 feet; that Well No. 1 on the Turner "B" Lease is producing from the Premier Sand, encountered at an approximate depth of 3100 feet, and the eighteen remaining wells on the Turner "B" Lease are producing from the Seven Rivers Sand, encountered at a depth ranging from 1885 feet to a depth of 2180 feet. At the present time Well No. 30, located in the Center of SE/4 SE/4 Section 17, Township 17 Scuth, Range 31 East, is drilling.

5. That Applicant, upon the basis of geological and engineering information, is advised and is of the opinion and belief that one well located on a forty-acre

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legal subdivision is not sufficient to obtain all of the recoverable oil . om the Grayburg Lime under any fortyacre tract, and that the drilling of "five spot" wells on portions of the Turner "A" and Turner "B" Leases, producing from the Grayburg Lime, at the locations shown on the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and by reference made a part hereof, would be in the interest of conservation, prevent waste and enable Applicant to obtain a greater ultimate recovery c. oil, in that Applicant would be able to recover substantial quantities of oil which would otherwise not be produced if such "five spot" locations are not drilled.

6. That Applicant hereby makes application to drill twelve such "five spot" locations, to be located upon the Turner "A" and Turner" B" Leases, hereinabove described, numbered and located, as follows:

> TURNER "A", Well No. 24: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1280 feet East of the West Line and 1280 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

> TURNER "A", Well No. 25: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2560 feet East of the West Line and 1280 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

> TURNER "A", Well No. 26: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet West of the East Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

> TURNER "A", Well No. 27: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 28: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2665 feet East of the West Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 29: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1295 feet West of the East Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

the location of each of said wells being shown on the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A".

7. That if permits are granted to Applicant to drill the unorthodox locations hereinabove described, said drilling program, as to said locations, will be carried on in an orderly and continuous manner, and that while Applicant proposes to drill all of said locations, it does not

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wish to be obligated to do so for the reason that as such locations are drilled, the data and information obtained from the drilling of such wells may cause Applicant to change or modify its future program with reference to the drilling of all twelve unorthodox locations hereinabove described.

8 That in the event an order is entered by the Oil Conservation Commission granting permission to Applicant to drill the hereinabove described unorthodox locations, that as said "five spot" wells are drilled, it is not Applicant's intention, nor does Applicant ask that it be granted any allowable in addition to the daily allowable as fixed monthly by the Oil Conservation Commission for each forty-acre proration unit. In instances where a "five spot" location, when completed, constitutes the second well upon a legal forty-acre subdivision, then it is the intention of Applicant to produce from the two such wells producing from the Grayburg Lime, located upon such forty-acre legal subdivision, the allowable as fixed by the Oil Conservation Commission for the forty-acre proration unit upon which said two wells are located, and in no event will the combined daily production from the two Grayburg Lime wells located upon any forty-acre legal subdivision exceed the allowable for the Grayburg Lime production, as fixed by the Oil Conservation Commission, for such forty-acre proration unit.

9. WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that the Commission set a date for hearing this application, in accord-

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ance with its rules and regulations and that upon presentation of this application, Applicant be granted permission to drill the twelve unorthodox "five spot" locations hereinabove described, and further, that a proper order be entered granting permission to Applicant to produce the daily allowable from the forty-acre proration unit upon which a "five spot" location constitutes a second producing well, at such rate as will, in no event, exceed the allowable for Grayburg Lime production, as fixed by the Oil Conservation Commission for the forty-acre proration unit upon which said two wells are located.

That from inception of production on the Turner "B" Lease, which occurred on or about November 21, 1938, there have been drilled a total of twenty-nine produeing wells; that ten of said wells are producing from the Grayburg Lime, encountered at an approximate depth of 3400 feet; that Well No. 1 on the Turner "B" Lease is producing from the Premier Sand, encountered at an approximate depth of 3100 feet, and the eighteen remaining wells on the Turner "B" Lease are producing from the Seven Rivers Sand, encountered at a depth ranging from 1885 feet to a depth of 2180 feet. At the present time Well No. 30, located in the Jenter of SE/4 SE/4 Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, is drilling.

5. That Applicant, upon the basis of geological and engineering information, is advised and is of the opinion and belief that one well located on a forty-acre legal subdivision is not sufficient to obtain all of the recoverable oil from the Grayburg Lime under any fortyacre tract, and that the drilling of "five spot" wells on portions of the Turner "A" and Turner "B" Leases, producing from the Grayburg Lime, at the locations shown on the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and by reference made a part hereof, would be in the interest of conservation, prevent waste and enable Applicant to obtain a greater ultimate recovery of oil, in that Applicant would be able to recover substantial quantities of oil which would otherwise not be produced if such "five spot" locations are not drilled.

6. That Applicant hereby makes application to drill twelve such "five spot" locations, to be located upon the Turner "A" and Turner"B" Leases, hereinabove described, numbered and located, as follows:

> TURNER "A", Well No. 24: Section 10, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1280 feet East of the West Line and 1280 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

> TURNER "A", Well No. 25: Bestion 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2560 feet East of the West Line and 1280 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

> TURNER "A", Well No. 26: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet West of the East Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the 3/2 of Section 18;

> TURNER "A", Well No. 27: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.N.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

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TURNER "A", Well No. 28: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2665 feet East of the West Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 29: Section 18, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.K., 1295 feet West of the East Line and 2405 feet South of the North Line of the 3/2 of Section 18;

TURNER "A", Well No. 30: Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 975 feet South of the North Line;

TURNER "A", Well No. 31: Section 19, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.H.P.M., 2665 feet East of the West Line and 975 feet South of the North Line;

TURNER "B", Well No. 31: Section 17, Township 17 South, Hange 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1345 feet East of the West Line and 1085 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 S/2 of Section 17;

TURNER "B", Well No. 32: Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 2005 feet East of the West Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 S/2 of Section 17;

TURNER "B", Well No. 33: Section 17, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1295 feet West of the East Mine and 1295 feet South of the North Line of the S/2 S/2 of Section 17;

TURNER "B", Well No. 34: Section 20, Township 17 South, Range 31 East, N.M.P.M., 1295 feet West of the East Line and 1295 feet South of the North Line;

the location of each of said wells being shown on the map attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A".

7. That if permits are granted to Applicant to drill the unorthodox locations hereinabove described, said drilling program, as to said locations, will be carried on in an orderly and continuous manner, and that while Applicant proposes to drill all of said locations, it does not

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wish to be obligated to do so for the reason that as such locations are drilled, the data and information obtained from the drilling of such wells may cause Applicant to change or modify its future program with reference to the drilling of all twelve unorthodox locations hereinabove described.

8. That in the event an order is entered by the 011 Conservation Commission granting permission to Applicant to drill the hereinabove described unorthodox locations, that as said "five spot" wells are drilled, it is not Applicant's intention, nor does Applicant ask that it be granted any allowable in addition to the daily allowable as fixed monthly by the Oil Conservation Commission for each forty-acre proration unit. In instances where a "five spot" location, when completed, constitutes the second well upon a legal forty-acre subdivision, then it is the intention of Applicant to produce from the two such wells producing from the Grayburg Line, located upon such forty-acre legal subdivision, the allowable as fixed by the 011 Conservation Commission for the forty-acre proration unit upon which said two wells are located, and in no event will the combined daily production from the two Grayburg Lime wells located upon any forty-acre legal subdivision exceed the allowable for the Grayburg Lime production, as fixed by the Oil Conservation Commission, for such forty-acre proration unit.

9. WHEREFORE, Applicant prays that the Commission set a date for hearing this application, in accord-

ance with its rules and regulations and that upon presentation of this application, Applicant be granted permission to drill the twelve unorthodox "five spot" locations hereinabove described, and further, that a proper order be entered granting permission to Applicant to produce the daily allowable from the forty-acre proration unit upon which a "five spot" location constitutes a second producing well, at such rate as will, in no event, exceed the allowable for Grayburg Lime production, as fixed by the 011 Conservation Commission for the forty-acre proration unit upon which said two wells are located.
