### ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico on July 25, 1950 on the motion of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission and upon the recommunities of the Southeastern New Mexico Nomenclature Committee.

FINDS:
