IN THE MATTER OF THE DEFINITION, CLASSIFICATION, AND EXTENSION OF THREE GAS POOLS IN SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

CASE NO. 233 ORDER NO. R- 31

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

This case came on for hearing at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on 24 August, 1950, on the motion of the Oil Conservation Commission, and upon recommendation of the Northwestern New Mexico Nomenclature Committee. The Commission having heard the evidence and having taken the case under advisement,

FINDS:

1. It has jurisdiction of this case and of the parties interested, due notice of this hearing having been given.

2. The following area, to wit:

All of Sections 7 and 18, in Township 27 North, Range 11 West and all of Sections 12 and 13 in Township 27 North, Range 12 West in San Juan County, New Mexico

comprises a separate common gas reservoir, the producing horizon being Pictured Cliffs and should be designated as the West Kutz Canyon (Pictured Cliffs) gas pool.

3. The boundaries of LaPlata (Mesaverde) gas pool heretofore created and described should be changed so as to include the following:

Township 31 North, Range 12 West

S¹/₂ Section 2 All Section 3 All Section 4 N¹/₂ Section 5 E¹/₂ Section 9 W¹/₂ Section 12 W¹/₂ Section 13 E¹/₂ Section 16

Township 32 North, Range 12 West

Township 32 North, Range 12 West (Continued)

All of the lands above described constituting a separate common reservoir of gas, the producing horizon being Mesaverde.

4. Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 10 West is within the common gas reservoir heretofore named and defined as the Fulcher Basin-Kutz Canyon (Pictured Cliffs) gas pool and should be added to said gas pool.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. A new gas pool to be known as the West Kutz Canyon (Pictured cliffs) gas pool is hereby named, designated and classified and shall include the lands described in Paragraph 2 above.

2. The boundaries of LaPlata (Mesaverde) gas pool are hereby changed to include the lands described in Paragraph 3 above.

3. The Fulcher Basin-Kutz Canyon (Pictured Cliffs) gas pool is hereby extended to include all of Section 6, Township 27 North, Range 10 West.

IN THE MATTER OF THE APPLICATION OF ROWAN OIL COMPANY FOR AN ORDER REDUCING THE ALLOWABLE OF THE BRUNSON PCOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This case came on for hearing on November 22, 1949 and the Commission having heard the evidence, the argument of counsel and being duly advised,

FINDS:

1. It has jurisdiction of the subject matter and of the interested parties, due notice of the hearing having been given.

2. Under the rate of production heretofore adhered to the Brunson Pool has suffered a rapid decline in bottom hole pressures and increasing irregular water encroachment, which are causing waste.

3. To prevent waste the top unit allowable of the Brunson Pool should be reduced to 90 barrels per day for a period of not less than 6 months, during which period the operators may conduct tests and gather data as to the characteristics of the reservoir.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. Commencing February 1, 1950, and until the further order of the Commission, the top unit allowable for the Brunson Pool shall be 90 barrels per day.

2. The general rules pertaining to gas-oil ratio tests (Rule 301) and gasoil ratio limitation (Rule 506) shall remain in effect, the gas-oil ratio limit being 2000 cubic feet of gas for each barrel of oil produced.

3. On August 24, 1950, a further hearing shall be held to determine if this order shall be modified, rescinded or continued in effect.
