Q Are you the same Daniel S. Nutter that testified in the previous case, Number 3012?

The extensions to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool is identical to that shown on the docket with one additional thing, I would recommend that the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, Township 25 North, Range 3 West, also be added to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool.

The hearing is adjourned.

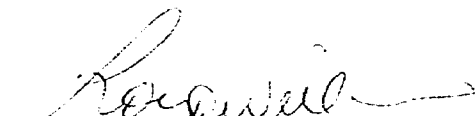

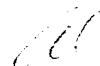
