

THE APPLICATION OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN FOOLS IN CHAVES, LEA, AND ROOSEVELT COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on November 18, 1964, at Senta Pe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 20th day of November, 1964, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Strawn formation, said pool to bear the designation of West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool. Said West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool was discovered by Sunray DX Oil Company, New Mexico State "AS" No. 1, located in Unit G of Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 33 East, NMPM. It was completed in Strawn on August 4, 1964. The top of perforations is 10,007 feet.
- (3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tobac-Pennsylvanian Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the Milnesand-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, the Lovington-Paddock Pool and the Lusk-Strawn Pool, both in Lea County, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Strawn production, is hereby created and designated as the West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following described area:

TOWNSHIP 11 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST NMEM SECTION 29: RE/4

(b) That the Lovington-Faddock Fool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(c) That the Lusk-Strawn Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretefore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:

(d) That the Milnesand-San Andres Pool in Roosevelt County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, is hereby extended to include therein:





- O Be seated please. Will you state your name and position for the record?
- A Daniel S. Nutter, Chief Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q Are you prepared to make recommendations to the Commission this morning concerning the creation and extension of certain pools in Lea, Roosevelt and Chaves County, New Mexico?
 - A. Yes, I have.
- Q And are you prepared to make recommendations in the form of an exhibit?
 - A Yes sir.
 - Q How is that identified?
 - A This is identified as Exhibit A in Case 3146.
- Q Is that Exhibit A similar to the docket that's been prepared here today?
 - A In most respects, it is.
- Q Would you please refer to your exhibit and point out any substantial changes?
- A Yes. On the creation of the West Bagley pool I'd like to state that this pool was discovered by SunRay, "SS", well number 1 is located in Section 29, Township 11 South, Range 33 East and was completed in the West Bagley August 4, 1964 with perforations at 10,007 feet. As to the extensions of various pools, they are all as shown on the docket with the



following additions. In Paragraph C, the Lusk-Strawn Pool should be as shown plus the Southwest quarter of Section 35 and the Southwest quarter of Section 32 in Township 19 South, Range 32 East. In paragraph D, the Milnesand-San Andres Pool should be as shown plus the following addition: Township 8 South, Range 34 East, Southeast quarter 30, Northwest quarter Section 31. In Paragraph E as shown on the docket plus the following addition: the south half of the Northwest quarter and the north half of the northeast quarter in Section 20, Township 8 South, Range 33 East.

Q Was Exhibit A prepared by you or under your supervision, Mr. Nutter?

A Yes.

MR. DURRETT: I move the introduction of Exhibit A and that concludes my examination of Mr. Nutter.

MR. PORTER: Without objection the exhibit will be admitted.

(Whereupon, Commission's Exhibit A was admitted into evidence.)
