ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on April 19, 1967, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this 24th day of April, 1967, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Lea County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Middle Pennsylvanian formation (Bough D), said pool to bear the designation of Nonombre-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool. Further, that the discovery well for said pool, Midwest Oil Corporation's State "D" No. 3, located in Unit F of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, is entitled to and should receive a bonus cascovery oil allowable in the amount of 52,295 barrels to be assigned over a two-year period. The top of the perforations in said well is 10,459 feet. Special vertical limits: top pool at 10,455 feet, bottom pool at 10,523 feet. Type log: above-described discovery well.

- (3) That there is need for the creation of a new oil pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the San Andres formation, said pool to bear the designation of Many Gate-San Andres Pool. Said Many Gate-San Andres Pool was discovered by H. L. Brown, Jr., O'Brien No. 1, located in Unit D of Section 7, Township 9 South, Range 30 East, NMPM. It was completed in San Andres on January 15, 1967. The top of perforations is 3261 feet.
- (4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Cato-San Andres Pool in Chaves County, New Mexico, the North Anderson Ranch-Wolfcamp Pool, the Antelope Ridge-Morrow Gas Pool, the South Corbin-Strawn Pool, the South Flying "M"-Pennsylvanian Pool, the Fowler-Blinebry Pool, the Justis Tubb-Drinkard Pool, the Lusk-Morrow Gas Pool, and t. Paduca-Devonian Gas Pool, all in Lea County, New Mexico. Further, that the proposed extensions to the North Bagley-Lower Pennsylvanian Pool and the West Bagley-Pennsylvanian Pool, both in Lea County, New Mexico, should be dismissed pending further study.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool for Middle Pennsylvanian (Bough D) production, is hereby created and designated as the Nonombre-Middle Pennsylvanian Pool, consisting of the following-described area:

That the discovery well for said pool, the Midwest Oil Corporation State "D" Well No. 3, located in Unit F of Section 32, Township 13 South, Range 34 East, NMPM, is hereby authorized an oil discovery allowable of 52,295 barrels to be assigned to said well at the rate of 72 barrels per day in accordance with Rule 509 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.





MR. HATCH: Case 3552 Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature case, calling for an order for creation of one pool and the assignment of an oil discovery allowable therein.

JOHN W. RUNYAN, called as a witness on behalf of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, first having been duly sworn, was examined and testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY MR. HATCH:

- Would you state your full name and position for the record, please?
- Α John W. Runyan, Geologist for the Oil Conservation Commission.
- Are you prepared to make recommendations to the Commission concerning the creation of an oil pool assignment of oil recovery allowable to the discovery well Midwell Oil Corporation State G Well No. 3?
 - Yes, sir. Α
 - Q Are your recommendations prepared in the form of an

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Exhibit?

Yes, sir, also I recommend a change in the acreage allocation for the pool instead of the northeast portion of Section 32, the west half of the northeast quarter and east half of the northwest quarter.

- What exhibit number is that?

- Will you please refer to the exhibit and explain your recommendations to the Commission as to the creation of the pool? Excuse me, let's go on -- what will the discovery allowable amount to?

Section 3, southeast quarter Section A, west half of Section
9, northwest quarter Section 12, south half Section 16,
northwest quarter Section 17, northwest quarter of Section 23,
all in Township 8, Range 30, and paragraph J has the addition
of the northeast quarter Section 15 and that's all of the
changes.
