2. Applicant wishes to drill and dually complete in the Undesignated Devonian and Ellenburger pools its Meyer A-29 Well No. 11 at a non-standard location 990' FNL and 660' FEL of Section 29, T-22S, R-36E, Lea County, New Mexico.
3. That dual completion in the Devonian and Ellenburger gas pools will recover reserves that would not otherwise be recovered.
4. That there are dually completed Devonian and Ellenburger wells in the Langley Devonian and Langley Ellenburger pools adjoining the Meyer A-29 Lease.
5. That the granting of this application will prevent waste and will not impair the correlative rights of any party.

WHEREFORE, applicant respectfully requests that this application be set for hearing before the Division's duly appointed examiner and, upon hearing, an order be entered authorizing the dual completion of the Meyer A-29 Well No. 11 at the described location.
