FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That Aztec Development Company is the owner and operator of the Finch Well No. 1, located in Unit O of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.
- (3) That in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights said Finch Well No. 1 should be plugged and abandoned in accordance with a program approved by the Aztec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on or before September 1, 1980, or the well should be returned to active drilling status or placed on production.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That Aztec Development Company is hereby ordered to plug and abandon the Finch Well No. 1, located in Unit O of Section 15, Township 29 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, or in the alternative, to return the well to active drilling status or place the well on production on or before September 1, 1980.
- (2) That Aztec Development Company, prior to plugging and abandoning the above-described well, shall obtain from the Aztec Office of the Division, a Division-approved program for said plugging and abandoning, and shall notify said Aztec office of the date and hour said work is to be commenced whereupon the Division may, at its option, witness such work.
- (3) That jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.


