Maddox Energy Corporation, by its undersigned attorneys, hereby makes application for an Order pooling all interests in the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations underlying N½ Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, and in support thereof would show:

 Applicant is entitled to proceed with the drilling of a well located on N¹/₂ Section 23, Township 24 South, Range 28 East, N.M.P.M., Eddy County, New Mexico, under the authority of Applicant's ownership of oil and gas leasehold interests therein.

2. Applicant proposes to drill its Earl Guitar Well No. 1 1980 feet from the North line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 23, to a depth sufficient to test the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations and seeks to dedicate the N½ of Section 23 to the well. Applicant has requested the owners of the remaining working interest in N½ Section 23 and royalty, overriding royalty and unleased mineral interest owners in N½ Section 23 to agree to participate in the drilling of said well or to farmout or otherwise commit their interest to said well, but certain owners so far have refused to do so. The parties who have refused to so participate are Sun Gas Company and the interest owners in the Willow Lake Unit. Aminoil USA, Inc. is the Unit Operator of the Willow Lake Unit.

3. The pooling of all interests in the Wolfcamp and Pennsylvanian formations in N½ Section 23 will avoid the drilling of unnecessary wells, prevent waste and protect correlative rights.
