#### ORDER OF THE DIVISION

#### BY THE DIVISION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 a.m. on January 28, 1981, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Examiner Daniel S. Nutter.

NOW, on this 12th day of February, 1981, the Division Director, having considered the testimony, the record, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being fully advised in the premises,

#### FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Division has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the applicant, Morris R. Antweil, seeks approval of an unorthodox gas well location 660 feet from the South line and 660 feet from the West line of Section 28, Township 18 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, to test the Morrow formation, Penasco Draw-Morrow Gas Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(3) That the W/2 of said Section 28 is to be dedicated to the well.

(4) That a well at said unorthodox location will better enable applicant to produce the gas underlying the proration unit.

(5) That no offset operator objected to the proposed unorthodox location.

(6) That approval of the subject application will afford the applicant the opportunity to produce its just and equitable where of the gas in the subject pool, will prevent the economic loss caused by the drilling of unnecessary wills, avoid the augmentation of risk arising from the drilling of an excessive number of wells, and will otherwise prevent waste and protect correlative rights.

#### IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That an unorthodox gas well location for the Morrow formation is hereby approved for Norris R. Antweil to drill a well to be located at a point 660 fest from the South line and 660 fest from the West line of Section 28, Township 18 South, Range 25 East, NMPM, Penasco Draw-Morrow Gao Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico.

(2) That the W/2 of said Section 28 shall be dedicated to the above-described well.

(3) That juriadistion of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
