

Enduring Resources KWU 2309-19K 3RF-43 Primary Liner Compromise Repair Report

Enduring reached the 20% incremental volume at KWU 2309-19K 3RF-43 on 11/3/2021. Enduring commenced the 24hour test on 11/4/2021. After 24 hours, Enduring observed roughly 2 minutes of leak detection pumping. With the continuation of similar leak detection pump times and similar water quality, the data indicates small amounts of water continue to migrate to the leak detection system as filling operations continue. Enduring Resources concludes that the primary liner continues to be leak free and filling operations have commenced to the next 10% milestone.
