The New Mexico Energy, Minerals and Natural Resource Department's Oil Conservation Division (OCD) has reviewed your amended discharge permit application, dated February 18, 2022, for Artesia PTU LLC's Pretreatment Unit (PTU) located at the HollyFrontier Navajo Refining LLC (Navajo) Artesia, New Mexico Refinery (the Refinery). OCD has determined that the amended discharge permit application is administratively complete.

Given OCD's determination, Artesia PTU LLC must provide public notice within 30 days of receipt of this letter (i.e., April 3, 2022) in accordance with the requirements of 20.6.2.3108(B) NMAC to the general public in the locale of the PTU by each of the methods listed below:

- 3. Providing notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, to the owner of the discharge site if Artesia PTU LLC is not the owner; and

4. Publishing a synopsis of the notice in English and in Spanish, in a display ad at least three inches by four inches not in the classified or legal advertisements section, in the Artesia Daily Press.

The PTU is located at 190 S Freeman Avenue in the City of Artesia, Eddy County, New Mexico, 88210 in the SE/4 of Section 1, E/2 of Section 8, W/2 of Section 9, N/2 of Section 12, Township 17 South, Range 26 East, New Mexico Principal Meridian (NMPM), Eddy County. The 13,000 barrel/day PTU is being constructed in the southern portion of the Navajo Refinery property.
