

Targa anuncia la presentación de una solicitud para posibles descargas no intencionales en la Planta de Gas de Red Hills, ubicada aproximadamente a 21 millas al noroeste de Jal, Nuevo México, en la Carretera Estatal 128 de Nuevo México. La planta almacena 1,071,352 galones de aceite caliente, diésel, accite lubricante, aguas residuales, condensado y productos petrolíferos en tanques de almacenamiento sobre el suelo, y está diseñada para procesar 3,807,800 barriles por año de condensado y 1,805 millones de pies cúbicos estándar por día (MMSCDF) de gas natural. La planta es una planta de gas criogénica a través de la cual el gas natural y el condensado provenientes de instalaciones de producción de petróleo y gas cercanas se transportan por tubería para su tratamiento y procesamiento. Una vez recolectado en la planta, el gas natural producido se comprime mediante procesamiento criogénico, se deshidrata para eliminar el contenido de agua y se procesa para eliminar y recuperar líquidos de gas natural. Además del procesamiento criogénico, el gas ácido se dirige a través de un tratador de aminas para eliminar el sulfuro de hidrógeno (H2S), y luego se inyecta a través de dos pozos de inyección de gas ácido (Red Hills AGI #001; API 30-025-40448 y Red Hills AGI #003; API 30-025-51970). Los pozos de inyección también se utilizan para la captura de carbono mediante la inyección de dióxido de carbono (CO2). El permiso de vertido incluye una descripción de los materiales almacenados y utilizados ca la Instalación y de cualquier residuo generado. El agua subterránea se encuentra a aproximadamente 400 pies por debajo de la superficie del terreno y contiene concentraciones totales disueltas (TDS) que varán de 635 a 1,950 miligramos por litro (mg/L). El permiso de vertido aborda cómo se manejarán, almacenarán y eliminarán los líquidos y residuos solidos, incluyendo los procedimientos para prevenir un vertido accidental. Se abordan las acciones correctivas y medidas preventivas para derrames y fugas.

El NMOCD ha determinado que la solicitud está administrativamente completa y está en el proceso de preparar un borrador de permiso. El NMOCD publicará un aviso en su sitio web y distribuirá un aviso de la presentación de la solicitud a las agencias gubernamentales locales, estatales, federales, tribales o de pueblos, subdivisiones políticas, asociaciones de zanjas y concesiones de tierras afectadas según lo identificado por el departamento, y a las personas en una lista general y específica de la instalación mantenida por el departamento que han solicitado notificación de solicitudes de permiso de descarga. Las personas interesadas pueden obtener información, enviar comentarios y solicitar ser incluidos en una lista de correo específica de la instalación para avisos futuros. El NMOCD también aceptará del permiso y declaraciones de interés con respecto al borrador del permiso y creará una lista de correo específica de la instalación para personas que descen recibir avisos futuros. NOTICE OF PUBLICATION

Notice is hereby given that pursuant to New Mexico Water Quality Control Commission Regulations (20.6.2.3106 of the New Mexico Administrative Code), the following discharge permit application has been submitted to the Director of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division (NMOCD), 1220 S. Saint Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87505, Telephone (505) 476-3441:

Targa announces the submittal of an application for potential unintended discharges at the Red Hills Gas Plant located approximately 21 miles northwest of Jal, New Mexico on New Mexico State Highway 128. The Facility stores 1,071,352 gallons of hot oil, diesel, lube oil, wastewater, condensate, and oil products in aboveground storage tanks and is designed to process 3,807,800 barrels per year of condensate and 1,805 million standard cubic feet per day (MMSCDF) of natural gas. The Facility is a cryogenic gas plant through which natural gas and condensate from nearby oil and gas production facilities is transported by pipeline for treatment and processing. Once gathered at the Facility, the produced natural gas is compressed through cryogenic processing, dehydrated to remove the water content, and processed to remove and recover natural gas liquids. In addition to cryogenic processing, sour gas is routed through an amine treater to remove hydrogen sulfide (H2S), then injected through two acid gas injection wells (Red Hills AGI #001; API 30-025-40448 and Red Hills AGI #003; API 30-025-51970). The injection wells are additionally used for carbon sequestration through injection of carbon dioxide (CO2). The discharge permit includes a description of materials stored and used at the Facility and any waste generated. Groundwater occurs at approximately 400 feet below ground surface and contains total dissolved concentrations (TDS) ranging from 635 to 1,950 milligrams per liter (mg/L). The discharge permit addresses how liquids and solid waste will be handled, stored, and disposed of, including procedures to prevent an unintended discharge. Response actions and abatement requirements for spills and leaks are addressed.

The NMOCD has determined the application is administratively complete and is in the process of preparing a draft permit. The NMOCD shall post notice on its website and distribute notice of the submittal of the application to affected local, state, federal, tribal, or pueblo government agency, political subdivisions, ditch associations, and land grants as identified by the department, and persons on a general and facility-specific list maintained by the department who have requested notice of discharge permit applications. Interested persons may obtain information, submit comments, and request to be placed on a facility-specific mailing list for future notices. The NMOCD will also accept comments and statements of interest regarding the draft permit and will create a facility-specific mailing list for persons who wish to receive future notices. Prior to ruling on any proposed permit, the Director shall allow a period of at least (30) days after the draft permit is posted, during which time interested persons may submit comments.
