# 1. <u>Technical Testimony & Motion Practice</u>

- a. All technical testimony shall be presented to the Commission in writing through the Pre-Hearing Statement as contemplated in 19.15.3.11(B) NMAC, and shall be filed with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 3, 2021.
- b. Motions shall be filed with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 3, 2021.
- c. Responses to both Motions and/or Pre-Hearing Statements shall be filed with the Commission no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 10, 2021.
- d. No replies shall be permitted.
- e. Filing may be accomplished by first class mail to the Commission Clerk, Florene Davidson, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor, Wendell Chino Building, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87505, or electronic mail to OCC. Hearings@state.nm.us.
- f. Any person who presents technical testimony in writing shall attend the hearing online or via telephone and will be subject to cross-examination by the members of the Commission, the Commission's counsel, or another person who has filed a Pre-Hearing Statement on the subject matter of the person's direct testimony.

# 2. Oral Non-Technical Testimony/Oral Public Comment

- a. Any person who has not submitted a Pre-Hearing Statement may present non-technical testimony or make an unsworn statement at the hearing, and may offer exhibits at the hearing so long as the exhibits are relevant to the proposed rule and do not unduly repeat the testimony.
- b. Any person that wishes to present oral non-technical testimony to the Commission shall notify the Commission Clerk, Florene Davidson by first class or electronic mail at 3rd Floor, Wendell Chino Building, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87505, or <a href="https://occ.hearings@state.nm.us">OCC.Hearings@state.nm.us</a> no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 16, 2021.
- c. In order to ensure that all participants are able to participate in the hearing, notifications to the Commission Clerk shall include at least a name and telephone number of the person intending to present non-technical testimony.

- d. Any exhibits that will be offered in conjunction with non-technical testimony must be sent via electronic mail to the Commission Clerk, Florene Davidson at the above email address no later than 5:00 p.m. on December 15, 2021.
- e. Any person who presents non-technical testimony will be subject to crossexamination by the Commission, the Commission's counsel, or another person who has filed a Pre-Hearing Statement on the subject matter of the person's direct testimony.

### 3. Written Comment Period

- a. The written comment period will be 38 days starting November 9, 2021 and closing at 12 p.m. on December 17, 2021.
- b. Any person may submit written or electronic comments on the proposed rule no later than 12 p.m. on December 17, 2021, unless extended by the Commission or the Chair of the Commission, by first class or electronic mail to the Commission Clerk, Florene Davidson, 3rd Floor, Wendell Chino Building, 1220 South St. Francis Drive, Santa Fe, New Mexico, 87505, or OCC.Hearings@state.nm.us.
