SUPPLEMENTAL GAS PRORATION ORDER FOR THE MONTH OF NOVEMBER, 1974

This cause came on for public hearing by the Commission's Examiner, Richard L. Stamets, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on October 16, 1974, at 9 a.m., pursuant to legal notice for the purpose of setting the allowable production of gas from the following seventeen gas pools in Lea, Eddy, Chaves, and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico, for the month of November, 1974.

Atoka-Pennsylvanian, Blinebry, Bluitt-San Andres, Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian, Burton Flats-Morrow, Burton Flats-Strawn, Carlsbad-Morrow, South, Catclaw Draw-Morrow, Crosby-Devonian, Eumont, Indian Basin-Morrow, Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian, Jalmat, Justis, Monument McKee-Ellenburger, Todd-Lower San Andres, and Tubb.

NOW, on this <u>22nd</u> day of October, 1974, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the supplemental nominations of purchasers, the capacity of producing wells, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That the total nomination of purchasers of gas produced from the above-listed seventeen gas pools for the month of November, 1974, is 25,182,314 Mcf. The individual pool nomina-tions are as follows:

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(2) That the potential producing capacity of all gas wells in the seventeen gas pools listed above is in excess of the nominations of purchasers of gas, and in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, the production of gas from the above-listed seventeen gas pools should be limited, allocated, and distributed during the month of November, 1974.

(3) That the nominations of purchasers should be used as the basis for determining total pool allowable for November, 1974, for each of the seventeen gas pools listed above, provided however, that for any pool carrying a severe underproduced status, the total pool allowable should be less than the purchasers' nominations for that pool, and less than the anticipated production from the pool, in order to alleviate the underproduced status; and provided further that for any pool carrying a severe overproduced status, the total pool allowable should be more than the purchasers' nominations for that pool, and more than the anticipated production from the pool, in order to alleviate the overproduced status.

(4) That pursuant to Finding No. (3), the nominations from the following pools should be adjusted as shown, in order to determine total pool allowable for November, 1974:

(1) That for the month of November, 1974, the allowable production to be assigned the seventeen allocated gas pools in Lea, Eddy, Chaves, and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico, is as follows:

(2) That the allocation hereby set for the month of November, 1974, in the seventeen allocated pools in Lea, Eddy, Chaves, and Roosevelt Counties, New Mexico, shall be in accordance with the Commission Rules, Regulations, and Orders.

(3) That a proration schedule, duly prepared by the Commission and thereafter adopted for the month of November, 1974, is hereto attached and made a part hereof; it distributes and allocates the allowable production among the gas wells in the seventeen gas pools listed above for the period stated, in accordance with the Commission Rules, Regulations, and Orders.

The foregoing order shall remain effective until further order of the Commission.
