## ORDER NO. AG-46

## GAS PRORATION ORDER FOR THE PERIOD APRIL 1, 1981 THROUGH MARCH 31, 1982

This cause came on for public hearing by the Division's Examiner, Richard L. Stamets, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on February 11, 1981, at 9 a.m., pursuant to legal notice for the purpose of setting the allowable production of gas from the following fifteen gas pools in Lea, Eddy, and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, for the one-year period April 1, 1981 through March 31, 1982.

Atoka-Pennsylvanian, Blinebry, Buffalo Valley-Pennsylvanian, Burton Flats-Morrow, Burton Flats-Strawn, Carlsbad-Morrow, South, Catclaw Draw-Morrow, Crosby-Devonian, Eumont, Indian Basin-Morrow, Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian, Jalmat, Justis, Monument McKee-Ellenburger, and Tubb.

NOW, on this 12th day of February, 1981, the Division Director, having considered the preliminary nominations of purchasers, the capacity of producing wells, and the recommendations of the Examiner, and being otherwise fully advised in the premises,

## FINDS:

(1) That the total nomination of purchasers of gas produced from the above listed fifteen gas pools for the period April 1, 1981 through March 31, 1982 is 199,786,634 Mcf. The individual pool nominations are as follows:

Burton Flats-Morrow 10,452,996 M   Burton Flats-Strawn 393,280 M   Carlsbad-Morrow, South 7,858,700 M   Catclaw Draw-Morrow 5,063,889 M   Crosby-Devonian 261,800 M   Eumont 54,965,966 M   Indian Basin-Morrow 2,598,392 M   Indian Basin-Upper Pennsylvanian 15,167,916 M   Justis 1,001,500 M

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(2) That the potential producing capacity of all gas wells in the fifteen gas pools listed above is in excess of the nominations of purchasers of gas, and in order to prevent waste and protect correlative rights, the production of gas from the listed fifteen gas pools should be limited, allocated, and distributed during the one-year proration period commencing April 1, 1981.

(3) That all the producing gas wells, together with the expected completed or recompleted wells in the fifteen gas pools listed above, can produce a total of 199,786,634 Mcf without causing waste within the one-year proration period commencing April 1, 1981, and an allocation based upon such production would be reasonable and would protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That for the one-year proration period commencing April 1, 1981, the total allowable production to be assigned the fifteen allocated gas pools in Lea, Eddy, and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, is as follows:

(2) That the allocation hereby set for said one-year proration period in the fifteen allocated pools in Lea, Eddy, and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, shall be in accordance with the Division Rules, Regulations, and Orders.

(3) That the total allowable production for each pool as set forth shall be allocated on a monthly basis and shall be adjusted monthly to meet changes in market conditions as reflected by purchasers' supplemental nominations and actual gas production, in accordance with the Division Rules, Regulations, and Orders. -3-Order No. AG-46

The foregoing order shall remain effective until further order of the Division.
